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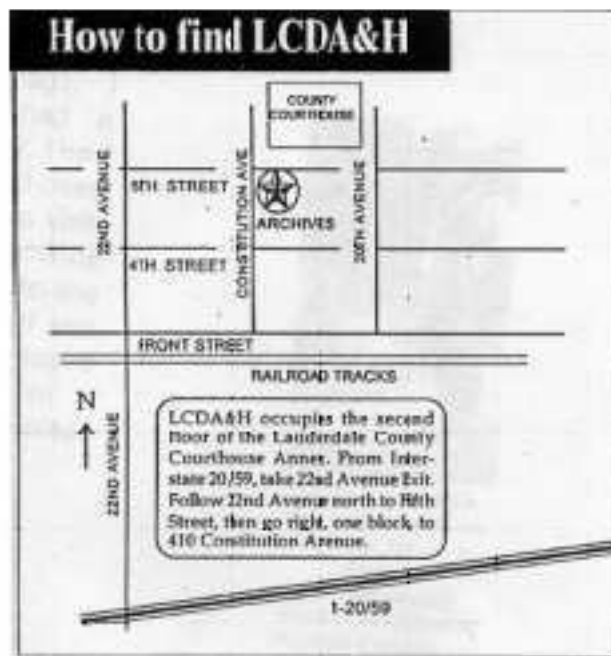

Liberty Baptist Association Minutes Introduction

The original Minutes of the Liberty Baptist Association which actually commence at the organization's second meeting in September 1839 are in the hands of Mr. Ware Mason, Route a Box 38, Silas, Alabama 36919.

Minutes of some of the annual meetings are missing. The last meeting occurred in September 1876.

These Minutes give the names of churches belonging to the Association, location of churches by post office and County, names of the ministers and delegates.

The abstract contains a running account, insofar as possible, of what occurred at the meetings. It also mentions other sister Associations.

This book is not indexed as many of the same names appear at the meeting. Please note that there are also many different spelling of last names of delegates and church names.

This abstract contains information regarding some of the earliest Baptist Churches. This is fortunate due to the fact that no records exist (individual church minutes) on some of the churches.

The Minutes cover churches in the following Counties: in Alabama - - Sumter, Choctaw, Washington; in Mississippi - - Jasper, Clarke, Lauderdale, Greene, Noxubee, Newton, and Wayne.

A duplicated copy of the original Association Meeting Minutes is on file in the Archives for public viewing.

All of the above named persons were ministers except S. Davis and Lemuel Callaway who were licentiates. F. B. Loftin, E. Mosley, J. Francis, J. Veazy, W. Woodward, W. L. Norman, G. F. Loftinand M. Wolf were absent.

Please note the two newly constituted churches in Lauderdale County, MS, assuming "newly" meant within the past year, the Oakey Valley and Bucketunney were organized in 1838. Oakey Valley Baptist Church in te present area of ther Meridian Waterworks Reservoir at Bonita. Bucketunney Baptist Church is still in operation at Snell in Clark County located south of Whynot, MS. It, like Salem Baptist Church at Alamucha, has withstood the trials of time and is with us today.

In these minutes of 1839 there is mention of the Bethel Baptist Association, the Leaf River Baptist Association, and the Cahwba Baptist Associaiton, the Mount Pisgah Associaiton and the Choctaw Baptist Associaiton.

During the period of this meeting, it was decided to lay off the Association into four (4) districts. District one: Hopewell, Christian Valley, Spring Hill, and Mount Zion. District two: Oakey Valley, Fellowship, Mars Hill, and Hebron. District three: Providence, Hurricane, Springs Bank(not listed above) and Union. District four: Clear Creek, Harmony, Bethlehem, adn Bucketunney.

The committee which had been assigned previously to examine a letter from the Harmony Church to the Association, which gave a report. The Commottee reported that a difficulty has originated among the members in regard to the charges, trials and exclusionof William Clark for indecoruous conduct, together with several others who were also excluded for declaring a non-fellowship with the said church for said chargers.

The members who were excluded had since constituted an anti-missionary church and had restored William Clark to membershipas well as to his ministerial office. Rev. Clark traveling and preaching with the same credentials that he had received from the regular Baptist. Rev. Clark had refused to give up his dredentials after demand by the regular baptist.

The Association regarded the whole proceedings of said constitution as illegal and contrary to gospel order. The Associaiton further cautioned brethern against said William Clark as being in gross disorder.

Five hundred copies of the AssociationmeetingMinutes were printed for sixty dollars.

The third anniversary minutes of the Association, held at the Clear Creek meeting House (Church). The Clear Creek Baptist Church was and is locatedat William Cross Roads, now Jackin (Choctaw County, AL) which was at the time in Sumter COunty, AL, but is now located in Choctaw County, AL. The meeting was held from the 4th - 7th of September, 1840.

It should be noted that in this set ofminutes the Association os referred to as the Baptist Liberty Associaiton.

The Providence Baptist Church of Sumter County, Al, a newly constituted church, along with Fellowship Baptist Church in Lauderdale County, MS, were found to be Orthodox and received into the Associaiton.

The various Baptist Associations would send correspondence

to the Association meetings. For example, the Bethel Baptist Association would send a bundle of minutes to the Liberty Baptist Association. . . the Liberty Baptist Association would do likewise to the Bethel and so forth. Circular letters (sermons, etc.) would be exchanged.

The Goshen Baptist Church of Jasper County, MS, petitioned for admission into the Association but due to some difficulty being experienced by Goshen Church with another Church in the Leaf River Association, the Goshen Church was advised to work with a convention of other churches to settle the difficulty. If this proved in vain, then apply to Leaf River Association praying her to try to release her of her difficulties.

On motion it was agreed to open communications with the Choctaw Baptist Association.

NOTE: The Salem Baptist Church of Alamucha was a member of this Association.

Mount Zion Church in Sumter County, AL was experiencing difficulty. The minority of the members regarded Brother James Veasy, the moderator of that church, as being heterodox in faith and discipline. After debate, James Veasy and the majority were excluded and the minority recognized as the true Mount Zion Church on a unanimous vote. Their delegates, Simon Ashford, Lemuel Callaway, and William Woodward, Sr., were invited to seats.

The Christian Valley and Hopewell Churches were granted letters of dismission from the Association upon request. Unless otherwise specified all delegates were ordained ministers or licentiates.

Fourth Anniversary Minutes of the Liberty Baptist Association held at the Oakey Valley meeting House from 23rd - 25th October A. D. 1841

The Mt. Pleasant Church in Newton County, MS, and the Salem Church in Jasper County, MS, petitioned the Association for admittance and the right hand of fellowship was extended.

According to a decision by the Association at its last meeting which declared James Veasy and his adherents to be in disorder, it was learned that they were continuing to be refractory. The Association proceeded to excluded them from the church. . . this being Mt. Zion Church. The minutes of the previous meeting were changed to reflect "withdraw from the majority" to replace "excludes the majority" in regard to the Mount Zion Church. Mt. Zion in Sumter County. AL near Rosser.

A committee was appointed to investigate the cause or reason which prevented the Spring Hill Church from holding communion with the Association.

It was during this period that the Association began to hold district meetings within the Association so as to allow ministers to exchange information and views

Minutes printed by the Sumter County Whig, Livingston, AL.

There is no record of the 1842 Association meeting.

Liberty Baptist Association minutes held with Hurricane Church in Washington Co. AL (organized 1817) on 21st-24th of October A. D. 1843.

The Quitman Church at Quitman (Clark Co. MS) was received as a newly constituted church and her delegates, N. Brady, Willorford and Davis, given the right hand of fellowship.

The newly constituted PHALTI in Jasper Co. MS applied for admittance but the Mars Hill Church delegates opposed and charged the PHALTI delegates were in disorder. A committee appointed to investigate the difficulty between the two churches.

A letter from the Baptist State Convention of Alabama presented by Elder N. (Nathan) Slay was ordered read and then placed on the table until Monday morning.

The PHALTI Church was admitted into the Association on Monday after objections withdrawn by the Mars Hill Church. The delegates, D. Sumrall, and E. Land, given the right hand of friendship. J. Thigpen, Sr. not present.

A query from the Mount Pleasant Church was read: "Is it Gospel order for any church that is a member of the Liberty Association to call a minister to their supply who has non-fellowed the Liberty Association and has constituted an anti-missionary church and received members without a letter from a church of your body?" The answer: "Any church of the Liberty Association calling such a man is in disorder. On motion and second the matter voted to lie on the table until the next meeting of the Association."

The second query was from Oakey Valley Church in Lauderdale Co. MS: "Is it consistent with Gospel order to receive and baptize a lady who is married to a man having another wife living?" The answer: "That the baptism of such a person is not recognized by the gospel."

There developed a difficulty between Liberty Baptist Association and the Choctaw Baptist Association during this period. This as best can be determined, is a difficulty within or over the Christian Valley Church in Sumter Co. AL, one body from the church desiring to join the Choctaw Association and another the Liberty Association. Committees from both associations to work toward a settlement of the difficulty.

1. In this report there was no designation for ministers.

2. Churches have the same name in many cases in different counties. This fact should be taken into account when referring to a long ago church.

Long CreekChurch, a newly constituted church in Clarke Co. MS, was admitted into the Associaiton and her delegates, E. Moseley, A. Fontaine, and A. McLemore was seated as delgates.

This church could have been the forerunner of the present Long Creek Baptist Church in Lauderdale Co., MS. It could also be one and the same church. In some areas during this period of time, people thought they were in one county but were actually located in another. Some people, no doubt, gave this matter little thought. The Clarke Co. MS line is but ashort distance from the present Long Creek Baptist Churtch.

A letter was secured from the Mississippi State Convention. Queries were dealt with as follows: From Harmony Church, "Does the liberty Association design that DomesticMissions shall be conducted in her body, or does she design to keep herself seperate from them?" The answer: " The query of such a nature as isunaswerable by a finite mind. However, for the present, we answer that the Association has no constitutional right to engage in Domestic Missions. But if in the event of Providence, the brethern should become harmoniuos upon the subject, the Association has a right to change the constitution so as to cover the subject."

From Oakey Valley Church, Lauderdale Co., MS: "Is it consistent with the principles of Christianity and Gospel discipline to reatin a man in fellowship who is a member of the Masonic Lodge?" The answer: "We, your committee, believing that the Association as a body knows so little of the principles of Masonry, are unprepared to say anything upon that subject. but from the immoral preactices of some of that frater-nity, believe it to be inconsistent for Baptists to associate with them in theor lodges until the fraternity reforms in practive. All of which is respectfully submitted. Signed by W. A. Carter, Chairman of the Committee."

The conflict between the two groups of Mount Zion Church and the two Associations, Choctzw and liberty, was continued, with both asso-ciaitions working toward a reconciliation. This is October 1844.

Those members of the Choctaw Association Committee were: Michael Ross, Rolly Spinks, - Alamucha, Lauderdale Co., MS; Robert Moseley, Harvey P. Brunson - in general area of Alamucha; G. W. Clinton, L. W. Brunson, Isaac Spinks - Alamucha.

Those members of the Liberty Association Committee were: Nathan Slay - Sumter Co. AL - now Jackin (Choctaw, AL) - William J. Callaway, W. P. Carter - lived south of the present Bonita area in Lauderdale County, MS. Prominent early Baptist minister and one of the first directors of the Mississippi Baptist Convention (Association), William Woodward, T. B. Lofton, Lemuel Callaway, James E. Scott.

It was decided to discontinue the annual circular letters.

A general letter was written and sent to sister Associations, Bethel, Leaf Rover, and Mount Pisga, acknowledging receipt of their letters.

It should be noted that Choctaw Co. AL was made from part of Washington Co. AL and from part of Sumter Co. AL in 1847. Thus some of the churches listed in these counties could now possibly be located in Choctaw Co. AL.

Liberty Baptist Association minutes of meeting held in the Buckatunney Church in Clarke Co. MS on the 23rd-25th of October A. D. 1845.

A committee appointed last session to visit and labor with the Mars Hill Church reported that they had met the church in conference and upon examination found that they had declared a non-fellowship with you (the Association) on the ground that you had departed from your constitution. After a due course of labor (we) failed to effect a reconciliation, therefore, we admonished and left them. This matter failed to be reported in the last (1844) Association Minutes.

The Ebenezer Church of Lauderdale Co. MS (present Causeyville area) applied for membership in the Association and upon examination were found orthodox in faith and were admitted. Also, the Siloam Church, Sumter Co. (near Ward) AL and the Liberty Church of Lauderdale Co. MS (near the AL line - south of old Alamucha) were admitted into the Association.

NOTE: The history of the Siloam Baptist Church and the Ebenezer Baptist Church are held by the Lauderdale County Department of Archives and History, Inc. A copy of the history of the Liberty Baptist Church is held by the Meridian Public Library.

The Jerusalem Church in Scott Co. MS is mentioned as the next meeting place (1846) for the Pisgah Baptist Association. Also the next meeting of the Bethel Baptist Association would be held in the Poplar Springs Church in Wilcox Co. AL, on the first Lord's Day in October 1846.

The Association appointed a committee to work with the Mars Hill Church, who had withdrawn from the Association.

The Association resolved, due to continued difficulties and divisions among the denominations, to recommend to all churches to set aside Friday before the first Sabbath in January next (1846) as a day of fasting and prayer and that no labor for gain be executed on that day from man or beast.

The Livingston Church and the Harmony Church of Sumter Co. AL requested letters of dismission which were granted.

It should be noted that this is the first mention of the Livingston Baptist Church being a member of the Association. Could Spring Hill Baptist Church in Sumter Co. AL be this church and a name change occurred?

Harmony Church reported the death of brother Elder Joseph Ryan stating the community lost a father and the church a faithful servant.

Liberty Baptist Association minutes of meeting held in the Phalti Church in Jasper Co. MS commencing on Saturday before the first Lord's Day in September 1846.

The Mars Hill Church was excluded from the Association.

Some of the minutes are missing but it appears that the Concord Church in Sumter Co. AL was admitted into the Association. Also, the following churches were admitted: Shady Grove, Wayne Co. MS,

Mt. Pisgah, Greene Co. MS, and Mt. Zion of Wayne Co. MS.

The 10th anniversary minutes of the Liberty Baptist Association convened with the Providence Church in Washington Co. AL on Saturday before the 4th Lord's Day in September 1847.

The New Hope Church of Clarke Co. MS and the Antioch Church of Washington Co. AL were admitted into the Association.

The Mars Hill Church of Jasper Co. MS which had been excluded from the Association was re-admitted.

The difficulty between the Choctaw Baptist Association and the Liberty Association in regard to the difficulty existing between Liberty Church, Lauderdale Co. MS (Alamucha) and the Mt. Zion Church in Sumter Co. AL was resolved - with both churches uniting as one church. (NOTE: The two churches only a short distance apart.)

The query from Zion Hill: "Is it consistent with Gospel order to retain a member on fellowship who is in the habit of distilling spirituous liquors?" The answer was: "It is the deliberate opinion of this body that it is contrary to the spirit and principle of the Gospel for churches to tolerate their members in the practice of distilling or retailing arden spirits as a beverage."

After a report from Brother Yarbrough that the Liberty Church in Lauderdale County, MS was in disorder, a committee was appointed to investigate and report at the next Association meeting.

The Elim Church, Clarke Co., MS and the Mt. Horeb Church of Lauderdale Co., MS were accepted into the Association.

In response to a request of the Concord Church to amend the Sixth Article of the Constitution, the Association replied: "This Association shall pass no resolution affecting the pecuniary interest of the churches or any member thereof - but she will take charge of all funds sent up by the churches or individuals - and appropriate the same according to the expressed wish of the donors - We are of opinion that the present constitution affords all the privileges that are necessary.

In reply to a request of the Newhope Church, "That this Association should spread the names of certain individuals on the minutes of this session" the Association answered that as an Association we do not consider it our duty to comply with said request.

Another query from the same church: "Is it consistent with Gospel Order for a church to retain a minister who has headed and led off the minority of a church by counsel?" The answer was: "We do not consider the query explicit therefore were oare of the opnion that itmust dependon the circumstances."

A Committee requested the following be printed in the minutes" "Though we wish to resign ourselves to the disposer of all evvents, yet we deeply deplore the loss of our beloved brethern, Elders George Davis and William Harrington, who have been removed by the hands of death since our last meeting. They were both zealouslaborers in the Lord's Vineyard, and we have great reason to hope that our loss is their eternal gain."

The Liberty Church in Lauderdale Co., MS received a favorable report. . . forexample the Mt. Pisgah, Bethel, ebenezer, Choctaw and Central Baptist Association.

I have also received information that Elder Nathan Smith departed this life about the 1st of June 1863 -- Elder Smith was a member of Clear Creek Church and was serving the Church at Hopewell, as pastor, and had sustained that relation for several years, and by whose death, said church is now left destitute and without supply.

In view if the loss of those 'laborers' in the 'vineyard of the Master,' and the scarcity of Ministers in our bounds, it behooves the Churches to sustain well those remaining among us, and to cultivate 'gifts,' among them, that the Gospel may be preached and the Churches supplied with the Word.
