History of the Church By Members 1958

We have no definite information as to the year when the Shubuta Methodist Church was established, but it probably was 1858, and the church felt at liberty to celebrate its Centennial in 1958.

Prior to the building of the Mobile and Ohio Railroad, Shubuta was a trading post on the Chickasawhay River, indicated on maps of Mississippi as early as 1832. The Choctaw Indians evidently gave it its name.

Our part of the State was acquired from the Choctaw by treaty in 1830. Clarke County was established December 23, 1833, with Quitman its county seat.

The Mobile and Ohio Railroad was completed from Mobile into Shubuta late in 1854, into Quitman on March 15, 1855, and into Enterprise on October 3, 1855. A complete section of land was surveyed into town lots and given the same name it had had under Indian possession—Shubuta.

Our Methodist history began about this time. all of Clarke County appears to have been mission territory until 1853, from which date there is a record of churches and pastors. Quitman Church claims its establishment was in 1853; McGowan's Chapel in 1857 and Shubuta in 1858.

The earliest publicity found is a notice in the New Orleans Christian Advocate September 26, 1860, signed by our pastor J.D. Cameron, and reading "At Shubuta a meeting has just closed resulting in the addition of 48 whites and 6 blacks, 35 of these being by conversion. A year ago a dozen members worshipped here under a brush arbor; now we have a neat new church with over a hundred members."

From 1858 to 1869 we were in Mobile and Alabama Conferences. Since 1870 we have been in the Mississippi Conference. From 1858 to 1912 our church belonged in circuits with other churches in the county. In 1913 Shubuta became a railroad station and has held that status ever since. A very disturbing fact today (1994) is that we have only 97 members.

Our first church building was erected in 1860 and served until 1891 when the present sanctuary was built under the ministry of Rev. J.P. Drake. This was dedicated June 21, 1891, by Bishop Charles B. Galloway. The west annex was built in 1913 and

the south annex in 1931. Even though the main building is 67 years old, we have an adequate and comfortable plant, air-conditioned throughout, a nice kitchen and a tower broadcasting system. An unusual feature of our building is its three steeples. In one of these steeples is a deep toned large bronze bell, a gift to the first church by one of its original members, a Captain Carr, whose name is engraved on it. The bell is seldom rung now, having been superseded by the tower chimes.

Whatever success the Church experienced is due to the lives of the consecrated men who have served as our pastors. According to Methodist policy, the Church has never been without a pastor.

History of the Shubuta, Mississippi

Before arrival of the white man on the scene, Choctaw Indians lived on the banks of the Chichasaha in a camp called Shubuta, the name in their language meaning "Smoky Water," so-called from the smoky cast of the limy stream. Another legend concerning the name is that an Indian started home with some meal, slipped off a log into the creek, and exclaimed "Shubuta!" in this case "sour meal." Still another is that growing a bountiful corn crop, which prepared them for peace or war, they ground it into meal and began preparation for "Busk," their ancient harvest festival. A heavy rain came, soaking the meal and souring it. A howl went up from the angry Indians, who, arms and tomahawks swinging wildly, shouted "shubuta," over and over, voicing their frustration over the spoiling of the crop, to the thud of stamping feet.

The first road across the state, the old Fort Stevens-to-Natchez highway, passed through this smoky water settlement. In 1805 the United States Government bought, or maybe just took, from the Choctaw, the land from the coast to this Fort Stevens-Natchez highway. The treaty line was surveyed. Notice on your Mississippi map a sharp, south-projecting dip across the Chickasaw River in the old Choctaw boundary line. Hiowanee, chief of the Shubutas, met the surveying party in the forest just east of his camp with the laconic command, "Go south" and south the surveyors went, for once using common sense rather than government red tape, saving their scalps and leaving the Smoky Water settlement in the possession of the Indians.

But the Treaty of Dancing Rabbit Creek in 1830 moved the Choctaw west, depopulating the camp, leaving it to numerous relics, lends and their burial mounds.

There was a trading post in the area as early as 1831.

In the early 1850s the Mobile and Ohio Railroad came, locating shops and roundhouses at Shubuta, and trade and opportunity abounded. Shubuta became a populous trade center known from the Tombigbee to the Pearl. Ox-wagon caravans from Alabama and the Mississippi "cow country" to the southwest as far as Covington, Jones and Lamar counties brought their produce to sell and socks filled with money to buy, and Shubuta grew and grew. For those who wished to stay overnight there was a section of land inside the town set aside for use as a campground. Water, feed for their stock, and a place to build a campfire were available to the weary traveler. Incorporated in 1853, the town was the largest between

Mobile and Meridian. It boasted a good depot and a regular telegraph operator who received and sent messages. Telegraphy preceded the telephone as a means of conveying news from afar. In the summertime, excursion trains stopped in Shubuta to pick up baseball fans who wished to attend the games being played in Mobile.

In the early 1900s, Shubuta was noted for its many artesian wells, some fifty of them. One, in fact, dug some 350 feet, was in the middle of a street, where a gazebo was built over it. The gazebo was later moved to the end of the street, where it still stands. Hydraulic rams used in conjunction with the wells pumped water into elevated tanks as a supply for indoor plumbing. The water was the color of iced tea.

At this time the town had two churches, the Baptist, originally called "The Friendship Church," organized in 1856, and the Methodist, organized in 1858 (although Mr. S.A. Jones says that his grandfather, Samuel Jones, a Methodist minister, preached in Shubuta under a brush arbor in the 1830s. The bell in the belfry of the Methodist church, given by one Captain Carr, a railroad conductor whose name was engraved on the side, still calls the faithful to service on Sunday mornings. There are now three white churches and two black ones.

The Shubuta Female Academy, a pioneer school for the education of women, dated from 1867, and its public high school continuously maintained a nine-month "A" grade school. There was also the Shubuta Institute and the Military Academy, with a faculty of five and 144 students. The curriculum included elocution, music, Latin, mathematics, science, and Greek. In 1932, in the depths of the Great Depression, 100% of the thirteen high school graduates continued their education in college.

Living in Shubuta in the early 1900s were many well-educated and cultured people. The town was on both the Lyceum and Chatauqua circuits, which offered diversified programs including concerts, comedy skits, lectures by well-known speakers, and magic shows by outstanding performers. In the town or nearby were held frequent, colorful fairs, where one could see the usual agricultural exhibits, horse racing both flat and harness, and air shows, an unusual treat. By 1910 or 1911, the town had its own motion picture palace. Movies were shown at intervals in a room over Patton's warehouse, sometimes referred to as "Patton's Opera House." Miss Louise Box presided at the piano. In the daytime, the seat were pushed back and the arena became a skating rink. The Woman's Music Club encouraged local talent and brought in artists for concerts. In addition to the Masonic Lodge, organizations included The Woodmen of the World, the Knights of Pythias, and other fraternities. Mr. C.A. Stovall published the weekly

Mississippi Messenger (having begun in 1879), and it is reported that he sat in the front window hand-setting type one letter at a time. His newspaper was the first published in the area.

In addition a number of gins operated in or around Shubuta, as did a cottonseed oil mill, an ice plant that later was to make delicious ice cream, a light and power plant, the large Brownlee Lumber Company, a cafe, a pressing shop, a shaving parlor, the Shubuta Furniture Company, advertising Victor Talking Machines, the Whitehead and Rainwater Jewelers, Nettles Hardware store, three dentists, a telephone exchange using the old "ring bell" system, two banks, Peoples and the Bank of Shubuta, which opened in 1902 with capital of \$25,000 and at this writing was still going strong, four lawyers, a meat market, a bottling plant owned by Mr. Nettles and making Payola soft drinks, two hotels, the Crown and the Pool. Services were offered by Mr. Patton, the undertaker, a blacksmith, two contractors, two milliners, a livery stable and feed store, three drug stores, eleven or twelve mercantile and grocery stores, two garages - the one behind the bank assembled the Model A Ford from parts shipped in by rail - four doctors, and a Mr. Harry Searl, trader in horses and mules. There may have been others.

But the Mobile and Ohio closed its shops and the agricultural economy was nearly destroyed by the depredations of the boll weevil. The town survived, however, owing to the beginning of the sawmill era. Demand for lumber and lumber products brought several large mills to the area, which currently is home to extensive activity in oil and gas. Like millions of other Americans from small towns, young Shubutans have been drawn away to the cities to make their marks, but their home has quietly survived, small but progressive, and it is hard to go anywhere in Mississippi or surrounding areas and find someone not aware of the influence Shubuta wielded in the past.

The committee appointed to investigate charges against several brethren reports the following: Interviewed Bros. Frank Case, Alvin Saltenstall, & S. R. Moody in regard to the charges and they acknowledged that their walks have not been as they should have been, and they are sorry and have pledged to each other to be more devoted to the duties of the Church. They appear to be penitent

and ask the Church to overlook their shortcomings. Also saw Bro. G. W. Lower and looked into his case and find that his object was to detect those parties that proposed to send him spurious money and that they did not propose to send him counterfeit money at first when they wrote to him to become their agent. After ordering their goods, not knowing what they were and upon arrival found out, he refused them. They offered him the package at half the C.O.D. amount which he refused and then offered it for \$2.50 which he refused. He has letters of proof.

We have also seen Bro. I. Champanois and we have no proof that he has any interest in any drinking saloon further than he has loaned his son J. F. Champanois money to carry on his business and that he was paid interest on his money. As to the swearing charge, we have no proof, except he confessed that he called someone a "damn rascal".

It was reported that insurance on church had expired. J. E. Rainwater appointed to raise money and insure church as soon as possible. D.W. Heidelberg appointed to raise money and have stoves put up in church and to arrange pipes so they would not smoke. Conference adjourned.
