He continues to seek information on the parents of ROBERT MORROW ALFORD who was born July 14 1848 in Monroe County, Virginia (WV) [*Both the 1880 and 1900 census of Missouri show his birthplace to be Missouri*] and died July 7 1899 in Lexington, Lafayette County, Missouri. He married Florence Elizabeth BARROWS January 9 1873 in Papinville, Bates County, Missouri. Tradition has it that ROBERT M. ALFORD was the son of THOMAS

W. F. Alford, Marion, Miss., was born in Greene county, Ala., October 1, 1827, and is the eldest of a family of ten children. His parents, Julius and Sarah (Sanderford) Alford, were both natives of Franklin county, N. C.; there they grew to maturity and were married. Shortly after their marriage they removed to Greene county, Ala., where they resided ten years, and thence to Lauderdale county, Miss.; this was in 1836. Mr. Alford bought land from the government and engaged in planting. He built houses, cleared the land, and soon had a good portion of it under cultivation. He was a harness and shoemaker by trade and was also a cooper; however, he devoted the greater portion of his time to planting. His wife was a member of the Baptist church, but he was a member of no church. He met with a violent death in 1860, when he was killed by a falling tree. Mrs. Alford is still living and is now in her eighty-third year. For the past five years she has been totally blind. The Alford family originated in England but were among the early emigrants to America. W. F. Alford the subject of this notice, assisted his father until he was twenty-seven years old. At the age of twenty-nine years he was married to Miss Sarah C. Crawford, of Marengo county, Ala., a daughter of Rev. Andrew J. Crawford. Mr. Crawford was a noted minister of the Methodist Episcopal church. Mr. and Mrs. Alford have had born to them nine children, six of whom are living: Anna (wife of J. S. Ross), Alice (wife of Z. Y. Craver), Lulu (wife of Romeo Glasscock), Eliza (wife of Charles Early), Joseph and William A. The mother died at her home in Lauderdale county in 1870. Mr. Alford was married a second time, in 1872, to Mary E. Parke, a daughter of Benjamin F. Parke, a prominent business man of Lauderdale county. Five daughters were born to this union: Alatha, Virginia, Frances, Ellen, and one who died in infancy. Mr. Alford owns four hundred and twenty acres of land, two hundred being under cultivation. He has lived on this plantation for the past twenty-five years. In 1858 he was elected sheriff of Lauderdale county, and served in that capacity ten years. For four years before his election he was deputy sheriff. For five years he has served as treasurer of the county, and is the present incumbent of that office. He is a candidate for reelection in the fall of 1891. He has been constable and assessor of the county a number of times, and has been elected to public office a greater number of times than any other man in the county. He is a man of superior business qualifications and has discharged his various duties with a fidelity that has won him the entire confidence of his constituency. He is a member of the Presbyterian church, and his wife belongs to the Methodist Episcopal church. He has been a member of the Masonic fraternity since 1850. He is a member of the Farmers' Alliance.

David J. Allen is a prosperous merchant and planter of Bolivar county, Miss., but was born in Grenada county of this state on the 14th of February, 1858, the sixth of seven children born to David A. and Elmina C. (Jones) Allen, natives of Mississippi and Tennessee respectively. David A. Allen was a merchant and planter, resided in this state for over forty years and died in Memphis, Tenn., in 1878 at the age of sixty years. He served in the Confederate army during the Civil war. The maternal grandfather, Isaac Jones, was one of the first settlers of the city of Memphis, Tenn., having removed there at a very early period. David J. Allen was educated in the schools of Memphis, his opportunities being well improved, and in 1876, at the age of eighteen years, he was better prepared than the average young man to fight the battle of life successfully. He began with no capital, received \$10 a month for his labors, but wisely spent his evenings in attending night school where he perfected himself in bookkeeping. After graduating at Robison & Leddin's business college in Memphis, he began keeping books in 1885, which occupation he followed for five years. At the end of this time he purchased an interest in the firm of J. W. Lyman.

A J Crawford Jr, a dentist, first married Virginia C Park (e) 6 Oct 1853 and Rebecca B. White 4 November 1879. He and his wife first lived in Hicklen, Alabama - Marengo Co. and in the winter of 1866 following the death of Andrew Jackson Crawford, Sr. moved to Marion Station.

Warren Fuller Alford married A. J. Crawford Jr's sister Sarah Crawford in Demopolis (Marengo Co.) Ala. 25 February 1857. She must have died following the 1870 census ^{+ antedating in 1871} and before Alford's second marriage to Mary E. Park (e) in 8 July 1873.

Mrs A. J. Crawford or Mrs Margaret Webster Crawford after settling her husband's estate in 1870 went to live near her children in Marion. She is in the 1880 Census. She was born Margaret W. Herman W. Alford, 72, a lawyer, died of cancer on Saturday, 24 September 1988, in F. G. Riley Memorial Hospital in Meridian, Mississippi.

In March 1983 Gil Alford received a letter from Mr. Herman Alford, Attorney at Law in Philadelphia, MS. The letter started as follows: "Your letter addressed to Pat Alford dated February 28, 1983, was opened by me, his father. I note that you had written him some previous letters to which he has not responded." There followed a warm five year association between Mr. Herman and Gil Alford with several exchanges of significant amounts of Alford information. Mr. Herman Alford made financial donations to both the association and before that to the work of Gil Alford. As member #68 he was one of the founding members of the association.

Herman W. Alford was born 26 September 1915 in Philadelphia, Neshoba County, Mississippi, the son of Benjamin Warren and Phronettie (Davidson) Alford. Benjamin's parents were John Madison Alford and his second wife Sarah Frances Cooper. John Madison was the son of John Alford born about 1800 in North Carolina. A complete chart on this branch of the Alford family was printed in Gil Alford's newsletter, *ABOUT ALFORDS*, issue #4, July 1983.

Herman married Gwendolyn P. Thomas 6 July 1942 and they had Herman Alford Jr., Patrick Alford and Janne Alford. Janne married Robert Thomas who was a law partner with

Mr. Alford.

Herman was a deacon at the First Baptist Church, where he taught Sunday school and held other church offices. He was a veteran of World War II and was retired from the Mississippi National Guard as a brigadier general. He was a member of the Philadelphia Masonic Lodge, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the American Legion, the Philadelphia Exchange Club and the Neshoba County, the Mississippi and the American Bar Associations. One of the most kindly souls who ever lived in our Meridian community is Mr. W. C. Rogers, Confederate soldier and gentleman. Retrieved from the paths of his memory comes the following:

"At Peter Bozeman's mill on Toomsaba Creek, about a half mile south of Toomsaba, the men folk of the community would meet and practice rifle shooting. This was during the years from 1854 to 1860 as I remember dates. They would meet every Saturday evening. Some of the club would put up a beef as prize and the best shot won. They used the best rifles to be had in that day. At one of our club meetings after the shooting match was over, George Finley, who was bookkeeper at the time for William Pigford, of Lockhart, stepped out about ten steps from Peter Bozeman and said, 'I am fool enough to let any man shoot a sardine off my head.' And Mr. Bozeman said, 'I can shoot it off.'"

"So the sardine can was placed on Finley's head (the red wrapper on the end of the box made a good target) and Bozeman put the bullet in the center of the wrapper. Alford Willis, being the next best marksman, said, 'I would like to take a crack at it.' His bullet struck a little bit to the right of the wrapper and a little lower down."

And here Mr. Rogers ended his account of by-gone days. Maybe it wasn't the Rebel "Yell" the Yanks feared so much after all.

THE YANKS' JAIL ON MRS. PIGFORD

After the fall of Vicksburg, 4 July 1863, William Tecumseh Sherman then in command of the Federal forces in Memphis was ordered to Vicksburg to relieve Gen. U. S. Grant who was ordered to Washington. The following winter General Sherman deduced upon a campaign of terror and destruction to further weaken the south. He led a sizable force eastward following the route of and destroying along the way the east-west railroad later known as the Alabama and Vicksburg.

He arrived in Meridian, Miss., 14 February 1864, and established his headquarters in this four year old town that had become a relatively large center for the storage of cotton, clothing and other materials needed for the Confederate men of combat. From his headquarters he sent out small detachments throughout the country with orders to destroy all instruments and supplies that might aid the rebels.

The word quickly spread that such a plan was being enacted. When Mrs. William Wells Pigford, Sr., recently widowed, received the news she reacted quickly by placing freshly slaughtered beef sprinkled with flour upon her front gallery. When the Yanks arrived she said "There it is boys, help yourselves." When asked what was sprinkled on the beef she answered, "Paris Green." (A common arsenic compound used in the south as a universal parasiticide). The soldiers who were bivouacked across the road walked away without touching her beef. They nevertheless made daily incursion over her premises thrusting their bayonets into the ground in search of buried meat.

THE LIFE OF WILLIAM DAVIS PIGFORD

Papa was born January twenty first eighteen hundred and ninety one in the house in Tonic where he now lives. He feels it a distinct honor to live in the same house all his life. He is the youngest of five children, three boys and two girls. The oldest child, a boy, died when he was a year and several months old. Papa never saw his oldest brother. When Papa was small, he played dolls with his sisters. The boys then wore dresses until they were several years old. Papa wore dresses until he was five years old and cried when they made him put on pants. When Papa was two years old, a cyclone came through Toomsuba and almost destroyed it.

Papa started to school at the Tonic schoolhouse that stood just beyond the present building. Papa finished public school in 1911 in the present Tonic school building. During public school life, Papa had to come home for dinner and miss most of the play period. Then, he thought that one of his greatest hardships. The school house was less than one fourth mile from his home. After school, he would hitch the horses to the wagon, haul in the cotton, haul wood, and help feed the farm animals. Papa had great fun, during vacation playing ball in the grove in front of his home with the neighbor boys. Of course, he helped on the farm. In the winter, especially during Christmas holidays, he clerked in his father's store. Papa entered A and M College September, 1911. While there, he played on the Lauderdale County football team. Because of the boll weevil coming to this part of the country, business conditions were bad; therefore, he remained in college only one year. When Papa was nineteen years old, his father died of typhoid fever. About 1912 Papa called a meeting of the trustees and patrons of Tonic school to talk over the matter of consolidation. The Tonic trustees called together a meeting of the trustees and patrons of surrounding schools together. Papa felt that through his efforts, one of the first consolidated schools in Mississippi was built, not in his own district but in the Kewanee-Alamucha district. Later this school consolidated with Toomsuba school, and at present our Dixie Highway school. In 1915 Papa called the neighbors and formed a telephone company. He was elected President of the rural telephone line. The line extended from Horne Lowe's to Toomsuba. Papa, with the help of neighbors, started the Tonic Literary Society. Because of his efforts, the neighbors made him president of the Society. Although Papa helped start the consolidation movement and feels proud of it, you never hear him speak or brag about it. In 1913 Papa visited the famous old historic city of Natchez. He crossed the Mississippi River where it is a mile wide. He crossed into Louisiana on a ferry boat.

In 1915 he went to Laurel as a delegate for the W. O. W. Papa went to Bessemer and Birmingham, Alabama. While there, he visited the red ore mines and where the ore is melted in furnaces and is run out as red liquid iron into sand to cool. When it is broken up, it is known as pig iron. Papa enlisted September 2, 1917 in the United States Army for the duration of the war. When called, he went to Montgomery, Alabama. While in the Army, they put glasses on him. While in the Army he visited the first whitehouse and Capitol of the Confederacy and stood on the spot where Jefferson Davis was inaugurated President of the Confederacy. A brass star on the porch of the State Capitol at Montgomery, Alabama marks the spot. He went to Tallassee, Alabama where most of the power for

the Alabama and Mississippi power companies is generated. Papa and several buddies in the army visited the town of Tuskegee and went through Tuskegee Institute. Tuskegee is a negro school, founded by Booker T. Washington, a negro slave who had been freed. Booker T. Washington once dined with Theodore Roosevelt, when he was president. Without going to France, Papa was discharged from the army in February, 1919. He married my mother in November, 1919.

In November, 1924, Papa, Mama, my brother, and I went to Hattiesburg, Laurel, and Gulfport. Papa went to the National Dairy Show in Memphis, Tennessee, in 1927. He saw the spot where Deoto is said to have stood, when he first viewed the Father of Waters. Papa went across the Mississippi River on a bridge and visited two towns in Arkansas. Papa served twice as Commander of the Woodmen of the World, twice as Master of the Masonic Lodge, and once as vice-commander of the T. O. Carter, Junior Post of the American Legion in Meridian. He experienced another cyclone in 1930. Papa is very fond of reading. Because of staying with his mother, his vocation, a farmer, was thrust upon him.

One of the greatest excitements of Papa's life was in 1931, when he ran for Representative of Lauderdale County, outside the City and was defeated by about one hundred and fifty or one hundred and seventy-five votes. He used to do a great deal of carpenter work. Papa does not have good health. He has some kind of stomach trouble.

THE LIFE OF JEFFERSON DAVIS PIGFORD

Grandpa was born November 9, 1853 near Toomsuba, Mississippi. He moved about two miles below Tonic when he was young. He spent most of his boyhood at Mount Gilead. Grandpa's great past time, when a boy, was hunting deer and other wild game. He played baseball, but had no gloves, mitts, or masks, as the boys of today have. One time Grandpa was sitting on a fence, playing with a crooked neck gourd. He held it in the crook of his arm. He fell off the fence and broke his arm and it was always crooked after that. When he was young, he weighed cotton with Mister Sharlie Pardon. During the Reconstruction days, Grandpa belonged to the original Ku Klux Klan. During one of their raids, he was riding on another horse behind Mister Monroe Keeton, when a negro shot Mister Keeton. Mister Keeton was an uncle of Mister Jackson Keeton of Toomsuba. Grandpa was seven years old when the Civil War began. He was a member of the W. O. W. and the Masonic Lodge.

Grandpa married in 1883. He built a house in Tonic where Grannie lives now. He was a farmer and kept a store in 1896 and left a good business at his death. Grandpa died of typhoid fever in 1910. He was broad shouldered and six feet and three inches tall. He weighed one hundred and ninety six at the time he was taken ill.

WHYNOT, MISSISSIPPI - The Whynot post office was originally Whitesville, established 23 June 1852. The name of this office was changed to Whynot 30 Dec. 1852. To select a name for the community letters were written offering suggestions. One letter read "Why not call it ----." They decided the first two words would be the name Whynot.

Dear Mrs. Barton:

Thank you for your letter of August 26, with check and family group sheets on your husband's Alexander descent.

I am transmitting herewith a copy of my first report on my research on the Alexanders, as well as copies of two letters to Doris Padgett which bear on your Asa Castellaw Alexander situation.

I am also enclosing a copy of an article from our March 1984 Quarterly, which I believe clearly identifies your husband's Wooten ancestry, certainly back to NC, and probably to Virginia and on to Northamptonshire, England.

On the basis of these materials, here is my analysis of your husband's Alexander and Castellaw ancestry, fairly certain in my opinion, but not without some problems.

First, let's assume that his descent back to Pheriba Alexander and Davis Williams Dawson is correct, and that she WAS daughter of Asa Castellaw Alexander. The question immediately arises: WHICH ASA CASTELLAW ALEXANDER? There were a lot of them,— I have records of at least five. The first Asa known to me is the son of Samuel Alexander Sr. of Georgia. Asa's son Asa certainly can not be father of Pheriba. But Old Asa's brother Samuel Jr. named one of HIS sons Asa Castellaw. THIS Asa MAY have been old enough in 1807 to be father of Pheriba.

It is therefore important to know the source for James Dawson's list of the children of the first Asa Castellaw Alexander. If it is a family Bible, when was it printed? Who made the entries? If it was printed many years after the recorded events took place, can the earlier entries be confirmed by genuine original source records made while the people concerned were still alive? To the modern scientific genealogist, family Bible evidence ranks low in reliability, particularly if the entries are dated before the Bible was printed.

Fortunately, we have at least one truly original source record which in my opinion proves Old Asa of Dale County Alabama to be the son of Samuel Sr. of Georgia, NOT of Samuel Jr. This is Asa's affidavit, made 20 October 1832 concerning his Revolutionary service, in which Asa gives his age as 72. This is in National Archives Microfilm Publication M 804, file S 32092.

This would make Asa born around 1760. I plan to include a copy of this document in my next Alexander report, in case you

don't already have it.

So it appears reasonably certain that Pheriba Alexander Dawson WAS daughter of the first Asa and his wife Faitha (Fatha) Wooten. In the enclosed article, you will find reference to a document showing Asa disposing of the 1/8th share of James Wooten's estate which came to him by right of his wife, leaving no doubt that Faitha was daughter of James Wooten and HIS wife Faitha Rogers.

You will find (in the article) similar reference to James Alexander's widow Tabitha disposing of HER 1/8th share of James Wooten's estate. Then you will find Samuel Alexander (Jr.) disposing of HIS 1/8th share which came to him by right of his wife, but his wife is NOT named. However, SHE HAS TO BE ANOTHER DAUGHTER OF JAMES WOOTEN, in order for Samuel Jr to be entitled to a share. We know from Samuel's 1819 will that he later married the widow Susannah Bush, but that he had by a previous wife four children, including HIS Asa Castellaw Alexander and James Wooten Alexander.

Undocumented family traditional materials refer to an Oliva or Olivea Wooten being wife of Samuel Alexander Sr. The best available evidence however shows that Samuel Sr.'s wife of many years and mother of all his children was BETHIAH CASTELLAW. Oliva/Olivea is thus almost certainly the FIRST wife of Samuel Jr, and thereby also another daughter of James and Faitha Wooten.

You will notice that the above items reveal some errors in the family group sheet on Samuel Alexander Sr sent to you by James Dawson. I'll list them all at this point, and follow with the evidence.

A. He was NOT born in Mecklenburg County NC, but more likely in the Perquimans/Tyrell area.

B. He probably died long before 1823; it was his son Samuel Jr who died about that time, saying he was of Twiggs County GA.

C. I have found no evidencethat Rev. John Alexander was Samuel Sr.'s father; the Duplin County NC records practically assure that Samuel Sr.'s father was an even earlier Samuel Alexander.

D. In the list of the children:

1. Samuel Jr.'s wives should be Olivea (?) Wooten and Widow Bush (not Rich).

2. The second son should be James Alexander; James WOOTEN Alexander was the son of Samuel Jr, so named in the latter's will (see pp 9-10 of the article).

3. Aseneth Alexander was certainly NOT born in Wilkes Co GA in 1760. IF she was daughter of Samuel Sr (which I doubt), she was more likely born either in Duplin NC or St. George Parish GA. She is not included in the most credible Alexander family Bible.

4. The same goes for Asa Alexander. His wife FAITHA was NOT his cousin.

5. John Lester Alexander is shown elsewhere as John LISTON Alexander.

7. Sarah Alexander was NOT BORN IN FAYETTE CO. in 1767; that county was not even created until over 50 years later.

Most of the errors listed above are fairly obvious; I should however like to know on what evidence ASENETH appears on this group sheet.

The most credible listing of Samuel's children appears to me a family Bible printed in 1849, which belonged to James Madison Alexander, eldest son of Moses Alexander Sr. who was youngest son of Samuel and Bethiah. This Bible was last reported (to my knowledge) in possession of Miss Louise Holcombe, Tuskegee, Alabama, a grand-daughter of James Madison Alexander.

It would appear that most of the entries were made by James Madison Alexander himself. He was born 29 June 1806, died 17 Jan 1891. His father Moses died in the spring of 1843, so there would have been ample contact between father and son up to that point. However, as this Bible was not printed until 1849, it is clear that most of the entries were made many years after the described events took place, and are therefore possibly subject to distortions through faulty memories. This record therefore should not be accepted as 100 % reliable, and the earlier items should where possible be confirmed by other original source documents made while those concerned were still alive.

The transcription in my possession was published by Mrs. C. L. Thompson, Hurtsboro Alabama, in TAP ROOTS, Vol. II, 4, April 1965, pp 178-179 (pub. Alabama). A copy is enclosed.

If anyone has more up-to-date knowledge of the location and ownership of this Bible, I should be glad to hear of it, if possible with photo-copy permitting us to examine the handwriting.

As to the origins of Samuel Alexander Sr, all signs point to North Carolina. Most important, we should expect to find him in a place where Alexanders and Castellaws are closely associated, since the Bible gives the marriage of Samuel Alexander and Bethiah Castellaw as of 1752.

This apparently eliminates the Mecklenburg NC area, since I have found NO records of Castellaws (any spelling) in that county. Contrary to my statement in the enclosed report, I HAVE now found a Mecklenburg record of a Samuel Alexander, buying land from Elizabeth Mitchell 2/10/1769, as mentioned in my letter to Doris Padgett. However, OUR Samuel Sr. had already moved to Georgia well before this time with his family, so this Mecklenburg Samuel is at most a distant cousin.

The evidence in my first report practically clinches that Samuel Sr was in Duplin County NC in the late 1750's, carrying chain in 1758 for his father Samuel along with his probable brother-in-law James Castellaw (Castolow). According to our Bible record, Samuel had already married Bethaih Castellaw 14 May 1752, but I have as yet found no confirming record in Duplin or elsewhere.

So where were the Samuels, father and son, before their Duplin 1758 land grant?

They may have been in adjoining Onslow County in 1754. The NC Colonial and State Records, Vol. XXII p 339, contain a Muster Roll of the Onslow Militia taking place 25 Oct 1754, in which Sam'l Alexander, Sergeant, is listed in Captain Hick's Company.

The earlier records show both Alexanders and Castellaws in the coastal counties further to the north. I am still in the process of collecting and studying these records, and expect to report fully on the results after my next research session in Raleigh, now planned for early November.

However, I already have enough for a highly probable identification of the wife of Samuel II (Sr. of Georgia), Bethiah Castellaw. This is found in the will of William Castellaw, made 18 June 1749, in Bertie County NC, a copy of which is enclosed.

Note that William does not name his father, who is clearly already dead. William also has no wife or children living, since none such are named. He gives the location of his plantation as at (or near) "Cusby Bridge the Court House". (This was before the county seat was established at Windsor.)

William names his mother Sarah Castellaw, leaving her the use of the plantation and all his slaves during her widowhood. After her death or marriage, William leaves the plantation to his brother John. He divides his slaves and other items among his brothers and sisters, named as follows in this order:

JOHN CASTELLAW, BETHIAH CASTELLAW, SARAH CASTELLAW, JAMES CASTELLAW, KATHERINE CASTELLAW, and THOMAS CASTELLAW.

Note that none of the sisters is married as yet, suggesting that most of those on the list may still be minors. Since James and Thomas received no land, it seems likely that they would move south or west to seek lands of their own. I conclude that it was the first sister Bethiah who married Samuel Alexander II and that her brother James probably moved with the latter to Duplin County.

NC Land Grant Book 17 (pp 39-40) shows a Thomas Castellaw receiving two land grants in Duplin County (188 acres and 70 acres, both issued 15 Feb 1764). This suggests that he may be the youngest brother Thomas, the last named in William's will.

We are fairly sure of the father of this family. I have found in NC Grant Book 3 (p 223) a 640 land grant to a James Castellaw in Bertie County, made apparently in the early 1730s. The Bertie Court Minutes (Book I p 78) for 13 Feb 1732/33 show a deed of sale from Jas. Castellaw AND HIS WIFE SARAH to Henry Edmonds. This practically proves James to be Bethiah's father. The last record I have found of this James is in the Bertie Court Minutes of 15 Feb 1743 (Book II p 427), where he appears as Justice of the County Court, and office which he had already filled for many years.

On the Alexander side, we find the dominant name among the earlier settlers in NC to be ANTHONY. One of these Anthonys made his will 29 July 1741 in Tyrell County, which at that time adjoined Bertie County. I am also enclosing a copy of HIS will, so that you may see for yourself how the name of Anthony's third son is written.

Like many other early NC wills, an original of this will was deposited with the provincial authorities, eventually winding up in the files of the NC Secretary of State. Summaries of a number of these wills were published years ago by Fred Grimes, in his ABSTRACTS OF NC WILLS, where it appears on page 4. On 8 Nov 1983, I compared the original with Grimes' abstract, and found that he had listed Anthony's third son as LAMUEL. Someone (possibly a well-meaning descendant) decided the name should have been LEMUEL, and so reported it. I therefore had a copy made by the NC Archives staff of the complete original.

Please examine the first page of the complete will carefully, specifically the end of line 13 and beginning of line 14. Here you will see the name which Grimes transcribed as LAMUEL. Compare the first letter with the initial capital S in the words "Shilling Sterling", and lower on line 17 the S of the name Sarah. Compare these with the L in the word LIFE on line 10 of page 1, or on line 11 of page 2.

The capital S and capital L are indeed very similar, but I believe the third son's name is SAMUEL, NOT LAMUEL. Notice

that Grimes gives a witness' name as GIDGOOD, a man whom I found elsewhere shown as BIDGOOD.

At least for the time being, this Samuel/Lamuel appears POSSIBLY to be identical to the first Samuel who received the Duplin land grant in 1758.

Notice that one of Anthony's sons is described as Anthony Jr. In fact, the name ANTHONY has continued in this family in Tyrell County for over 200 years. I have found other wills of an Anthony Alexander in Tyrell in 1758, 1784, 1821, and even 1921!

I hope to find more confirming evidence as to the relationships of all these people, as well as their further ancestry, during my next session in the Raleigh Archives, and will report the results to all concerned in due course.

I am sending copies of this report to several other Alexander descendants who have contributed to meeting the costs of this research project, as well as to James Dawson in case he may wish to participate.
