Everyone probably has the above; I recap it here for easy reference with the facts contained herein.

Facts are not presented in any kind of order; as they appear in various communications.

In 1870 Henry Harris, Albert M. Harris and Nancy A. Harris moved their letters from Liberty Baptist Church, Lauderdale Co; they show up in Newton Co in the 1870 census.

It is thought John Harris b Ala was the first child of Henry Harris.

Henry Harris married Cynthia Buckalew Lauderdale Co Ms 1843; her parents Zebulon & Polly Railey buckalew; the Buckalews lived either in Ala or Ms, on the border between the two states, and possibly in Clarke Co Ms. Some land records have been found in Clarke Co. Some of the Buckalews went to church at Liberty Baptist Church, Lauderdale Co Ms (church minutes 1870). A Buckalew relative in Mobile said Henry Harris lived at Whynot.

Henry Harris married Cynthia Bucklew Lauderdale Co Ms 1843. Her
parents, Zeulon & Polly Railey Bucklew. The Bucklews lived in
Ala or Ms possibly on or near the line; possibly Clarke Co. Land
records found in Clarke Co, Ms. showing Bucklews. Some of the Buck-
lews went to church at Liberty Baptist, Lauderdale Co vicinity
of Whynot. (Church minutes 1870).

1860 U. S. Census, Lauderdale Co Ms Whynot House No 162 shows
Henry Harris & Cynthia Buckalew Harris; they lived in the Antioch
area of Why Not close to Yantley in the Choctaw Co Ala Area.
The James Harris listed may have been Madison named after Cynthia's
father b circa 1848. Henry Harris, 10, named for his father b
1850. William Harris, 8, could be named after William Fortson who
was probably Henry Harris' grandfather. Benjamin Harris married
a Thompson. There was a daughter, Frances, born 1838, who married
a Thompson.

House No 1329 In household of Bryan C. Harrell & wife Sarah (Harris?)
is a John Harris age 16. Same area. Sarah had a son named John.
Bryan & Sarah's children: Butine? (female), John W. 12, Sarah 10.
Bryan C. Harrell listed as age 40, became a Primitive Baptist min-
ister; wife, Sarah age 40 born circa 1820 possible sister to
Henry. John may have been counted twice - in the household of Bryan
Harrell & Henry Harris.

QUESTIONS:

Since Henry Harris is a rather common name, we need to be careful
we do not mix them up.

It appears that Henry Harris b 1804 was married before he married
Cynthia Bucklew; & Albert M. Harris was probably the son of that
first marriage.

Could it be that Albert M. Harris is Albert Madison Harris:?

Where is Henry Harris buried? It would be like pulling teeth to
get the records of a church, but possibly could be found in
that; both church membership of Henry, Albert, Nancy and burials.

Henry Harris' son Zebulon Harris entered the war in 1862. (This Zebulon is the ancestor of Ann Harris family, Tx.) He stated in an affidavit for a pension he grew up in Lauderdale Co Ms, went to Newton Co Ms to enlist, he was in Co D 1st Miss Cav Forrest Cav & Capt A. B. Hunter was his officer (A. J. Brown's history of Newton Co 1894 for unit info). This unit went to Union, Ms to be inducted. (The Ms Dept of Archives & History states he did not enlist in Newton Co - there is of course a possibility of an error, but I find the Archives quite accurate.) It should be borne in mind most civil war pension applicants were elderly and often sick, the mind not like one of age 20 and the applicant unintentionally could have presented inaccurate information, or the relatives who helped him with the application did not have correct information. People do not lie, they do not have accurate information.

Zebulon Harris and his brothers Benjamin F. Harris & Henry Harris went to Texas shortly after the civil war but his sister, Cynthia A. Harris, & brothers James Harris & John Harris stayed in Ms.

Henry Harris b Ga 1804. Records show a Henry Harros born 1804 Wilkes Co Ga to West Harris & Amelia Ware Harris. This Henry went to Maury Co Tn as a minor after his mother died in 1810. Some think this Henry Harris died in that area in 1810 but no proof. No sure connection between him and Henry Harris - Ms.

Records show a Henry Harris in Marshall Co Ms 1840. The census records show no first names that year.

Was Albert Harris the son of Henry Harris by a first marriage? Albert Harris b 1827 Tippah Co Ms. Albert M. Harris buried in Newton Co Ms Poplar Springs Baptist Church which is maybe 8 miles southeast of the town of Newton, Ms - the tombstone readings are:

A. M. Harris 6/12/1827 10/23/1898 Companions gone, we doubly feel ourselves alone. Beside him: Nancy Welch Jan 1833 6/13/1904 She always made home happy. *See last page this report.

Marriage records 1813/1870 Jones Co Ga Henry Harris married Sarah Jones 9/4/1823; in the same book Henry Harris married Frances Goare (Gore?) 3/31/1825.

There are many records on Harris in Maury Co Tn; more than one Henry Harris & West Harris. If Henry Harris is the son of West Harris; & Henry in Jones Co Ga who married Sarah Jones the ones we are looking for, that it would seem seem to rule out the Maury Co Tn bunch.

The Ms Dept of Archives & History reports: Civil War Index reports these CSA's - 3 Albert or A. M. Harris, 13 Henry Harris, NONE in Newton or Lauderdale Cos (who enlisted here). So Henry and Albert, if they served in CSA, enlisted in other counties or even Ala. I did not check Zeublone enlistment.

The Ms. Dept of Archives & History lists on the grave registration: 7 Henry Harris (7) 3 Albert or A. M. none in Newton Co.

Newton Co Ms Courthouse records:

Deeds:

A. M. Harris to S. S. Brown 2/15/1879 2 acres NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 Sec 9 T 5 R 12 E Beginning or being 2 acres off the SW corner \$120.00. Deed from A. Harris accepted by A. J. Rainer in behalf of Newton Co Board of Supervisors; this land was probably purchased to straighten out a road, or widen it. The Rainers married in with some of Albert M. Harris' nieces/nephews.

Deed from A. M. Harris to H. Jefferson Pierce dated 10/8/1878 40 acres NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 9 Town 5 Range 11 East \$300.00 not recorded until 12/30/1886.

Both parcels of land is in the vicinity of Poplar Springs Baptist church about 8 miles south east of Newton, Ms.

Researchers in both Newton & Lauderdale Co Ms going on experience and records and instinct feel Henry Harris was either very unstable, or had problems; he moved around a lot.. Possibly he deserted his first wife and children.

The Lauderdale Co believes Henry was in Sumter Co/Choctaw Co Ala area, the lower part of Sumter Co until 1847 when it became Choctaw Co.

Zebulon Harris married first Mary M. Williamson from Ala in Texas. Second he married Ella Fair Butler. Zebulon went to Texas with

with a Butler family. This could have been the Elbert Butler family or a part of the William Butler family. The butlers are not in the Lauderdale Co Ms Census for 1860 or 1870. There were a number of Butlers but they are not found in the records after 1860. They all lived between Why Not & Causeville; there were 2 sets of Butlers.

Henry Harris may have been Henry Harrison Harris.

The Lauderdale Co Ms marriage in 1900 of D. Welch & Nancy Harris by Thomas H. Griffin J. P. - this was probably in Beat 4. The "D Welch could be Dempsey or Dennis -

1854 Dempsey Welch married Elizabeth Boswell.

1854 Dennis Welch married Rebecca Culpepper.

1870 William Ward married Mary Harris (the Wrds lived in the Antioch/ Why not area).

The children of Albert M. Harris & Nancy Harris are buried at Liberty Baptist Church, Why Not (Lauderdale Co Ms):

Phillip P. Harris

Jacob P. Harris

The Jacob P makes the Lauderdale Co researcher think Nancy was the daughter of Dr. Jacob Perry Welch of Alamucha. Liberty Baptist Church is near Alamucha on the NewtonCo line; they could have lived in Ala or Ms. It appears Albert & Nancy never had any more children.

At the time Cynthia married Henry Harris (1843) Henry's father Zebulon Harris was a member of Buckatunna Baptist Church at Energy at Clarke Co Ms just over the line from Why Not. The Harris' may have been members at Buckatunna, but Zebulon Harris probably lived at Whynot, Lauderdale Co Ms. In 1845 Zebulon Harris was a Charter member of Concord Baptist Church at Yantley, Ala. He was back and forth along the state line. The researcher checked Concord Baptist Church and Zebulon Harris was not listed later as a member.

This should have appeared earlier in this report with the listings for Blue Springs Baptist Church, Lauderdale Co Ms:

Harris, James I. 4/6/1861 11/6/1944 & Mary J. Harris 12/4/1859 3/30/1948.

There are many Harris' in NewtonCo Ms; the only sure ones I can tie to the Why Not area are Poplar Springs Baptist Church and possibly James at Blue Springs. There are later Harris' which may be tied in at Decedar Baptist Church maybe 10 miles south and west of Newton, Ms. on the Jasper Co/Newton Co line.

This report tries to put various information from different sources into one place. I have spent much time on this and will leave it to the reader to sort it out. Perhaps the parties involved can help one another.

Newton Co Ms Courthouse records:

WILL:

The will of A. M. Harris deceased was probated on 10/11/1909 having been written 10/17.1898. The will lists two CoExecutors L. W. Williams and N. A. Yarbrough. (Believed to be nephews of A. M. Harris.) The way the will reads either A. M. Harris had no children or they predeceased him. Albert directed that all his just debts be paid, then everything to go to his beloved wife, Nancy Harris to be hers ONLY IN HER LIFETIME; at her death the estate was to be equally divided between his nephew and niece, Nathan A. Yarbrough & Nancy Rainer. (There are many Yarbrough's and Rainers' buried at Poplar Springs as well as Albert & Nancy Harris.) A will like this is a sort of trust, the widow can use the assets she inherited but not sell them. (There are also many Williams buried at Poplar Springs, Albert & Nancy are buried at the foot of a fair number of Williams - the Williams are supposed to be close kin to the Harris or Nancy's people.)
