1. DAVID SMITH

(Revolutionary soldier, served under Cpt. Robert Masefield, as well as other tours. See original affidavit signed by Jefferson Sullivan, Magistrate, Oct, 1859. See also National Archives, Washington, D.C. "David Smith, No. 6082, widow, Rebecca) Rebecca can also be found on page 48 of the book, Revolutionary War Pension Applicants who served from S.C. by Janye Garlington Pruitt, 1946. Also see the book, Copy of Original Index Book Revill, Columbia, S.C., page 316. No. of Return 42. According to Sara Sullivan Irvin of Ware Shoals, S.C., David was held prisoner by the British but escaped and found refuge with the Lindley family, who hid him under the house. Later he married a daughter of the family.

William and Sara Philpot lived for a time in Bibb County, Alabama, but later moved to Alamuche community in eastern Lauderdale County MS. There are conflicting reports of the issue of William and Sara. According to Sara Sullivan Ervin of Ware Shoals, S.C., William and Sara had a son named William Jr., born 15 November, 1820, who with his wife Polly Pearson Smith, together with some relatives Isaac Roberts and wife, once visited the Lindley family in South Carolina. However, evidence suggests that there were 11 additional

children -- perhaps born, certainly reared in Lauderdale  
County MS.
