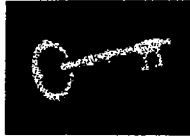

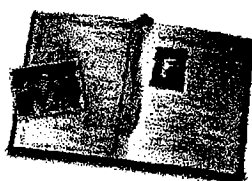

# Pine Chips

Dr. Shaw 22

JUDGING FROM the outside appearance, it seemed as if someone was receiving a large shipment of syrup, for the shiny, fifty gallon cans stood ready for pick-up on the boat deck. Such shipments came in several times each year from Montgomery, and while their destination was certain, no one ever determined their exact origin. They were marked for delivery to Service.

No farmer came to call for the tins, for the contents were much more precious than mere food, and the nectar far sweeter than any earthly syrup. The cans were for Miss Ernestine Irwin, a teacher at the Service school, and they contained the collected works of Dickens, Shakespeare, Wordsworth, Keats, Poe and Hawthorne.

WITH A rare insight, Miss Irwin realized that the classics would be as interesting to the school children of Choctaw County as they were to the scholars at Harvard. What a great awareness. We have it from some former students that the classics played well and were eagerly accepted in that area.

The school stood on the edge of the community, on the side opposite from the mill, but still near enough so that the third blast of the mill whistle signalled the start of the school day. Three teachers normally taught in the school, but sometimes the number varied. Some of the teachers were Maybelle Lindsey (Hathcock) of Jachin, Lucille Allen of Halsell, and Verna Mae Clements of Gilberttown. Knowledge of the tins and Miss Irwin allows us to state that the educational experience was superior.

HEALTH PROBLEMS within the community were the concern of Dr. Rowell Wilbur Shaw, the company physician. A medical pioneer in our area, Dr. Shaw's training and background reflected all the attributes that we associate with physicians of that era, for medical discoveries were coming about so rapidly that the doctors were ever healer and students. Let's consider the long road that Dr. Shaw travelled to attain a medical degree.

Rowell W. Shaw was born and reared in the Cuba community. He enjoyed the two mile walk from the family farm to the school and readily embraced the courses of study which included such higher subjects as calculus, geometry, latin and music. He graduated with honors at the age of sixteen. After

wards, he taught school for a short time at Scratch Hill and for a year at Edna. His sleeping accommodations at the second job were somewhat unique; a pallet on the floor of a cousin's home.

DURING THAT time, his father, a large cotton grower, passed away, and he returned to the family farm. Cotton, a commodity, closely follows the stock market; both lost their bottoms in the panic of the final decade of the last century. Young Rowell wanted to go to medical school but there was an extreme shortage of funds.

He stood for and passed the exam for postal worker on trains. At the time, that was a very dangerous position. The notorious Copeland gang and the James brothers made their living by robbing postal trains, because those conveyances also carried cash between various banks. Rowell's run was from Memphis to St. Louis, and on to Texas, gang territory all the way. Fortunately, his trains were never subjected to a hit.

ONCE THERE were enough funds on hand, he entered the medical school of the University of Tennessee at Memphis and graduated with high honors in 1900. Some of his schoolmates were the Christopher brothers, John, Walter, and Frank, and Sam Miller. All the students from the county received medical degrees. Dr. Shaw first practiced at West Bend, AL, a little town on the Tombigbee river.

In 1907, he took post-graduate studies for a year at the Poly Clinic, a division of Bellview Hospital in New York City. We remember the Poly Clinic because that is where our own Dr. Daniel T. McCall studied earlier. Dr. Shaw combined the practice of medicine and pharmacy by opening an office and operating several large drug stores in Birmingham during the years 1911-15. During World War I, he served in England and France as a surgeon with the American Red Cross.

AFTER THE war, he again combined medicine and pharmacy, and not in Birmingham but in Mobile where he operated two large drug stores which were later sold to Albright and Wood, a large drug store chain. One feature of early drug stores, the soda fountain, has virtually faded away, but let's consider it for the unique flavor that it fostered on American life for several generations.

Soda fountains were just that, and a whole lot more, for in addition to soda and seltzer, they also featured coffee and sandwiches. Such culinary items were served on a high counter around which there was a cluster of very high stools. Of course, there were a couple of booths for elderly people but they were always occupied by teen-agers who came early and stayed late. So much for the physical characteristics.

THE REAL virtue of soda fountains rested in the unseen, the spirit, or elan that pervaded the atmosphere, for here friendships were renewed or strengthened, and loneliness was an unknown quality. The fountains reached the height of their popularity during World War II when, more than ever, they were fountains of hope. Hitler suffered his first defeat at a soda fountain, and it was repeated millions of times as anxious parents shared news of their fighting sons with friends, or sometimes, complete strangers.

Dr. Shaw came back to Choctaw County in 1924, but he left occasionally again to take refresher courses at the Poly Clinic and at Tulane University. Most of his practice was around large saw mills from that time on because those companies allowed him to practice in the nearby communities. He worked for the Sumter Lumber Co. (forerunner of Allison) near Livingston, Alger-Sullivan Lumber Co. at Foshie, AL, and at Service. After the mill at Service closed, he moved to Gilbertown and practiced for

twenty-two years. AT THE beginning of his practice, the doctor rode a horse. When his practice ended, microbes in space labs were being sent to the rims of outer space. Within that period, knowledge in the medical field first doubled, then tripled, then quadrupled, and finally exploded with literally thousands of inventions and discoveries. Treatment moved from homes to hospitals.

Even so, one incident in Dr. Shaw's practice speaks volumes about him. In the middle of a high flood, on the darkest night, a man came to him at Service and asked for help for an illness at home. When someone protested that the doctor couldn't go, he quietly stated: "If they can get word to me, then I can get to them."

THE DOCTOR carried a county scar throughout the latter years of his life, and it was caused by the dirt road that once ran from highway 17 to Land. As he travelled north on 17 one day, a log truck pulled onto the highway from the Land road, and a massive cloud of dust covered the countryside, blinding the doctor. He hit the high bank in that area and sustained an injury that resulted in a permanent limp.

Picture here are some of the instruments of his profession. Pay particular attention to the mortar and pestle and the graduated flask and appreciate that the doctor compounded his own remedies. Other items are the surgical case which carried a variety of instruments to deal with everything from boils to amputations. The doctor's bag was standard for his era, and one of the most important items of all is the lantern. Not only did it light the way, it also bolstered whatever light was available in the crude homes.

DR. SHAW diagnosed his own condition and entered Barber Hospital and died in 1954. His legacy is still very much with us, as proved by the numerous persons who helped in bringing this series together. Our gratitude to you all.

Perhaps it is fitting that one of the cans brought the works of Nathaniel Hawthorne, for that great writer, in his "Twice-Told Tales," wrote of a doctor in early America who gave his all to the calling. He went to the bedside of a patient one night and set him on the road to recovery, even while himself suffering from bouts of ague. The patient awoke the next morning feeling fine, but the doctor's head rested on the side of the bed—
