Greer received 200 acres on Uchee Creek by headright and an adjoining 200 acres on an old warrant; in 1784 he asked the state of Georgia for 287½ acres in Washington County for his Revolutionary services. William Greer was born September 9, 1754, in Pennsylvania, lived in Rowan (now Iredell) County, North Carolina, from about 1763 to 1768, and in Richmond (new Columbia) County, Georgia, from 1768 to 1785, when he moved to Greene County, Georgia. He served as a sergeant in Capt. John Peake's company of militia, Lower Battalion of Richmond County, Georgia, in 1782. He was a justice of the peace in 1786, 1787, 1791, 1792, and 1799, an assistant justice in 1789, a surveyor in 1787-91, 1793, 1796, and 1799, a member of the Constitutional Convention from Greene County in 1788, and a justice of the Infarior Court from 1796 until his resignation in 1811; and a justice of the Inferior Court from 1796 until his resignation in 1811; he was probably also a trustee of the University of Georgia. He served as a private in Capt. James McNeal's company, Lower Battalion of Richmond He served as a private in Capt. James McNeal's company, Lower Battalion of Richmend County, Georgia, militia in 1782. He was a justice of the peace in Celumbia County, Georgia, in 1795, and was the administrator of his father's estate. On September 12, 1798, he obtained his father's 400 acre plantation at a sheriff's sale and sold it to James Lowe on Pebruary 23, 1802. JOHNSON of Greene County, Georgia

Robert Johnson was born about 1715 and probably lived in Pennsylvania before he moved to Rowan (now Iredell) County, North Carolina, about 1756.1 He made his will on April 28, 1757, leaving his land and property to his wife Lilly and seven children, and died shortly afterwards. On November 5, 1757, John McConnell of Rowan County received a grant from Earl Granville of 611 acres on the ridge between Rocky River and Catawba River for the orphan sons of Robert Johnson; on October 19, 1764, McConnell gave the land to the Johnson sons. Robert and Lilly Johnson had the following children: 2

Thomas Johnson was born March 10, 1742, and lived in Rowan (now Iredell) County, North Carolina, as early as 1757. On January 5, 1765, he and his brothers John and Robert sold 300 acres of their land grant to Simon McCormick for £50, and on September 11, 1765, they sold the remaining 311 acres to Adam Torrance for £100.3 Tom Johnson married Mary Dunlap (see p. 9) in 1765/6 and then moved to Uchee Creek in Richmond (now Columbia) County, Georgia, where his wife died about 1775. About 1779 he married Agnes Greer (see p. 10).

Johnson served in the First Battalion of Richmond County, militia in the American Revolution; on March 22, 1784, Colonel James McNiel certified that he had served as a refugee from 1781 to the expulsion of the British from the state. Johnson asked for bounty land in Washington County, Georgia, for his services; in 1785 he paid taxes on 2872 acres in Washington County and 550 acres in Captain Karr's district of Wilkes (now Greene) County, which lands were confirmed by grants from the state of Georgia in 1784 and 1786 respectively. He was also granted 200 acres in Richmond County in 1787.5 County in 1787.5

Tom Johnson was already living in <u>Wilkes (now Greene) County, Georgia</u>, on March 10, 1785, when he sold William Johnson 150 acres on Uchee Creek in Richmond (now Columbia) County. On September 28, 1787, he sold Thomas Stanley 287½ acres on the waters of Richland Creek in Greene County. In 1788 and afterwards, he paid taxes on 350 acres in Greene County. On July 20, 1790, he sold William Hays 100 acres on the North Fork of Ogeechee. part of his grant of 1786; on November 19, 1796, he gave his son Gilbert 30 acres from the same grant. On January 9, 1797, he sold land on Ogeechee to Hezekiah Cartwright, and on September 18, 1798, he sold 70 acres on Ogeechee to Peter Cartwright.

In 1800, Thomas Johnson was Greene County tax collector, and in the 1807 Georgia land lottery he drew lot #189, District 14, Baldwin County. 7 On December 26, 1804, he sold William King 22½ acres on the North Fork of the Ogeechee, and on January 22, 1814, he sold James Nisbet 108 acres and John Johnson 32 acres on the North Fork, part of the land where Thomas

lived. On January 30, 1816, he made his will, leaving his remaining property to his wife and two youngest daughters. He died on March 5, 1816.8 About 1817. Agnes Johnson and her children moved to Dallas County, Alabama, where she died on September 5, 1820.

Thomas Johnson was born September 30, 1772, and lived on Uchee Creek in Richmond (now Columbia) County, Georgia, until 1784; when he moved to a plantation on the north side of the North Fork of the Ogeechee River in Wilkes (now Greene) County, Georgia. It is sometimes difficult to determine which references are to him or to his father or others of the same name. 38

Thomas Johnson married Mary Taylor (see p. 145) in Greene County about 1807, and on August 7, 1808, he received an interest in 74 acres on the South Fork of Ogeechee, his share of the estate of his father-in-law, James Taylor, from the executors, and on August 11, 1808, he sold his share to Alexander Taylor, his brother-in-law, for \$165.00. On August 14, 1808, he bought 100 acres on the North Fork of Ogeechee from John Curtis for \$400.00; on November 22, 1811, he bought 59 acres on the North Fork of Ogeechee from William Greer for \$354.00.39

In 1812, Thomas Johnson was appointed guardian of Sarah Ann Taylor, his sister-in-law, and on January 21, 1814, he and the other heirs of James Taylor sold 187 acres on the South Fork of Ogeechee to Dennis Sheridan for \$600.00. For many years he was a justice of the peace and tax receiver in Greene County, and in 1817 he took the census in Major Nicholas Howard's battalion in Greene County.

In January, 1813, he and Martha Cartwright administered the estate of John Cartwright, and in 1816 he was an appraiser of the estate of Thomas Johnson, Sr. In September, 1821, he was administrator of the estate of his brother, Robert Johnson, and posted a \$7,000.00 bond with Gilbert Johnson and Alexander B. Taylor as securities. He bought part of Robert's personal property at his sale on January 11, 1822, and as Robert's administrator he sold land in Walton County to Henry Jones in November, 1823, and he sold four slaves to William H. George in Greensboro on January 1, 1828.41

Thomas Johnson continued to acquire land in Greene County; on September 1, 1815, he bought 250 acres on the Ogeechee from Alexander King for \$750.00, and the same day sold 55½ acres of it to Gilbert D. Johnson; on March 2, 1820, he sold 12.3 acres to James Dolvin. He recovered 128 acres on the North and South Ogeechee from Allen Shelton in a suit in March, 1821. In 1825 he was taxed on 384 acres and 10 slaves.

About 1828 Thomas Johnson moved to Newton County, Georgia, where he died, probably early in 1830. An inventory of his personal estate, taken on March 19, 1830, shows a total value of \$8,641.60, including 12 slaves valued at \$3,325.00 and many promissory notes, most of them made after his removal to Newton County. The slaves were divided among the widow and children, a guardian was appointed for the minor heirs, and the younger boys were sent to Jefferson Academy. 43

Thomas Johnson's plantation was divided after his death; Clayton Huff bought 125.3 acres, part of lot 211, First Walton District, except for the land reserved for the widow, for \$501.20 on March 27, 1833. On the same day, Alexander H. Luckie bought another 125 acres, the north half of lot 223, First Walton District, on the waters of Shoal Creek for \$1,300.37.

Mary Johnson died in 1835 in Newton County and her estate was inven-

toried on December 14, 1835, with a value of \$1,537.12, sold the same day, and the proceeds divided among the heirs. On April 5, 1836, Robert Rakestraw bought the remaining 124 acres, part of lot 211, First Walton District for \$801.50. On August 31, 1849, the children of Thomas and Mary Johnson sold lot 119, Seventh District of Henry County, Georgia, consisting of 2022 acres, to Waide H. Turner. 45
