Robert Gibbons Family

Robert Gibbons - no information on his life before marriage except info on tombstone in Fellowship Baptist Church Cemetery.

Permelia Mann - Permelia was the daughter of Watter Mann and Elizabeth ~~M~~ Pines Mann. Permelia was born March 8, 1799 in Edgefield District, South Carolina.

Watter and Elizabeth Pines Mann left Edgefield County, S.C. about 1813 for Conecuh County, Ala. where he was listed in the 1818 Tax List. The 1820 Conecuh County Census indicates that Watter and Elizabeth had a family 3 boys and 6 girls.

sometime during the 1820's as he and his family appear in the 1830 Pike County, Alabama Census. Watts Mann and family moved to Barbour County, Alabama in the 1830's as Watts Mann and family appear in the 1840 Barbour County Alabama Census.

Shortly after 1840 Watts and his wife left Alabama and settled in Arkansas. The Family Bible of William B. Mann lists Watts Mann died Aug 7, 1844 in Chicot County, Ark and his wife Elizabeth Mann died July 6, 1845 (place not stated)

Robert Gibbens married Penelope Mann. The date of marriage is not known. Robert Gibbens appears in the Pike County Alabama 1830 Census. The 1830 Census lists 1 male an age "5 and under 10". Based on this date their marriage was ~~about~~ before 1825.

Apparently Robert Gibbens and his family moved to Barbour County with the Manns as Robert Gibbens also appears in the Barbour County Alabama 1840 Census.

Whether Robert Gibbens left Alabama with the Manns is not known.

VI. E. G. Gibbons is hereby appointed Judge of the Probate
Court of Lauderdale County, State of Mississippi.
Hon Gibbons will, prior to entering upon the discharge
of the duties of his office, be required to execute, and
file with the proper officer such bond or other recog-
nizances as may be required from him by the Statute
laws of the State of Mississippi, and he will be further
required to take and subscribe the oath of office prescribed
by the act of Congress of July 2^d, 1862. The oath
properly subscribed will be forwarded to the Assistant
Adjutant General of the District for file.
