All of Charles and Rebeccas children were married in Lauderdale Co., Miss. except for Charles Alvin, William Lovelace and James Jefferson who were married in Texas. Rebecca Motte Gordon is buried beside her husband in the Brownwood, Texas cemetery. This is an exact quote of the newspaper obituary for Charles Gordon:

#### THE LATE CHAS. GORDON

" Mr. Chas. Gordon, the aged father of J.J. Gordon esq., of Georgetown, died at the home of his daughter near Bryan the last day of September of apoplexy after a few hours illness. His remains, accompanied by his youngest son, James, and oldest daughter, Mrs. Mott, were taken to Brownwood and interred beside his wife, who had predeced him to the grave by thirteen years. This was in accordance with a request made years ago of his son, James, who took a mournful pleasure in carrying out his father 's

wish.

Mr. Gordon was born in Georgia March 10, 1810, and was in his 92nd year at the time of his death, a ripe old age and an honored one, for he was emphatically "an honest man, the noblest work of God." He was married in Alabama to Miss Rebecca Mott, emigrated to Mississippi in the early settlement of that State, settled in Lauderdale county near where now stands the city of Meridian remaining there until 1866, when he moved to Cameron parish, Louisiana, where he lived until 1873, when he came to Texas and to Georgetown for the purpose of educating his two youngest sons, William and James, and his grandson, Joseph Suttles, in the Southwestern University. In 1887 he moved to Brown county, where the following year his wife died. In 1894 he went to Brazos county to spend his last days with his oldest daughter, Mrs. N.A. Mott, with whom he lived until he was called by the Master to his final rest in heaven, his death occurring about nine miles from Bryan on Sept. 30 at 7:10 a.m. and his burial in the Brownwood cemetery Oct. 2 at 4 p.m. Of the eleven children born unto him and his wife seven yet survive. Mr. Gordon was a farmer and very industrious by disposition, never being happy unless he was at work of some kind. He was always trying to find something to do and the day before he died he picked cotton. He was a lifelong Methodist and a man of intense religious feeling. Verily a good man has gone to his reward."

I do not believe the following to be a complete list but I got it from Mattie Tom of Midland, Texas a cousin on his mothers side to my Grandfather Robert E. Gordon. Mattie is one of his mothers sisters children. Mattie told me that both of the Gordon children came to live with her family after their parents died. That is how the Morris family happened to have Gordon family papers and information.
