## Gentlemen:

I am the grandson of Thomas W. Kynerd who was born about 1853 in Perry County, Alabama. Son of Jesse B. Kynerd & Harriet Caroline Wilkinson. He was the grandson of Jacob and Resanna Kynerd and of Dr. John & Lucy (Penick Wilkinson.

Between 1878 & 1878 he moved to Sparta, Chickasaw, Mississippi, where several of his first cousins lived. In october 1878 Thomas W. Kynerd married Mrs. Sallie Ella(Jemison) May. His wife died May 2,1914-since 1914 & 1921 he lived with the Lee E. Kynerd family.

I, Clyde E. Kynard, heard my grandfather say that he had a brother in Meridian, MS, and I know he visited him on several occasions-but I do not know his brother's name or any thing about him or his children- his brother to my knowledge never visited his brother T. J. Kynerd, in Sparta or Woodhand, MS, where my grandfather moved about 1921.

About 1968 I remember passing through Meridian on a bus and saw the name Kynerd on the side of a business building, which looked at a glance like a hardware store or business that might handle farm equipment or semething of the sort-but I can't be sure. Since I was born 1/27/08, I have never neard of a name spelled like this :kynerd who was not a relative of our relatives in Mississippi.

What I would very much like to know is the name of my grandfather's, brother who lived and died in Meridian- His name and his birth & death fate-also the names of his children and if any deaths, the dates-I feel thre his son or sone would have passed on-because, my father who was born in 1883 died in November 1962. But if there is someone of his kin who would have a Bible of these listings, I certainly would appreciate you getting in touch with them, and helping me to secure this information.

My blood pressure prohibits me from driving only short trips, or I would come over there and do my best to get as much information as possible.

My Grandfather, alle had a sister who married a deuter and was living in La., but I can't remember her name-one reason I can't remember her or his brother is bacause I never met either one.

I have a friend who is working on a recording of the Kynerd family-any information will be greatly appreciated.

My grandfather died about 1936, but I don't know whether he was older than his brother or not.
