The house was across the road from Sam H. Bozeman's home & ^{there} wasn't much to it. John Lovett had a job @ RR & he added to & remodeled old house. House ^{vacant} is still standing (1986) across road from Pine Springs Grocery & Bait Store

John and Marcus Hawkins both worked @ RR Shop in Meridian - They used to drive in to work together - John's horse & buggy.

John had a child by his 1st wife, Mattie White. The other children belonged to Elizabeth (Brown) Lovett
