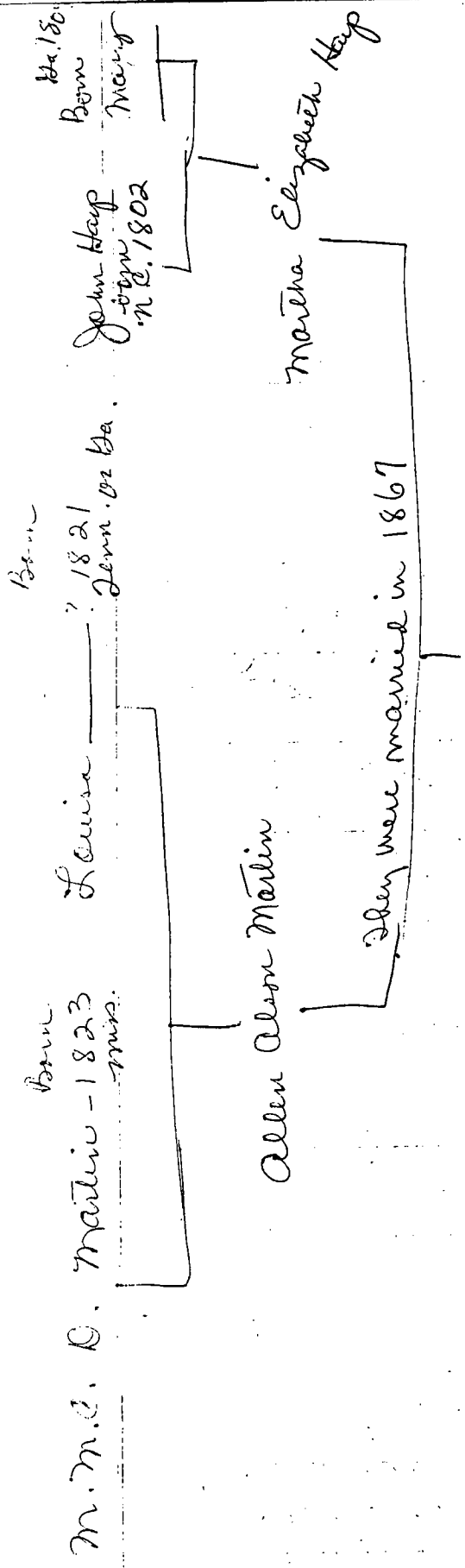

From Mississippi census records obtained from State Library in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, I found in Clark Co. 1850 - M.M.C.D. Martin (born in Mississippi) and his wife Louisa (born in Tennessee or Georgia) and their 4 children. Their son Allen, 2 years old, was my grandfather, Allen Alson Martin 1848-1903.

In 1850 census - Lauderdale Co., Mississippi
John Hays 48 born in North Carolina and his wife Mary Hays, born in Georgia and their children. Their daughter, Martha Elizabeth, 2 years old in 1850 was my grandmother. (1848-1904)

I saw their (Allen and Martha Elizabeth Martin) marriage license in Microfilm of early marriage records obtained for me by the Branch of the Geneological Society Library of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Salt Lake City, Utah. The license was issued to Elizabeth Hays and Allen Martin on November 29, 1867. They were married approximately December 1, 1867. I have found them listed in the Mississippi census records of 1850-60-70-80 and 1900.

The Martins (M.M.C.D.) (born in Mississippi) and Louisa ? born in Georgia lived in Clark County until the years of the Civil War. They apparently moved to Mendian in Lauderdale County at that time. I would like to know Louisa's maiden name.

The Hayes (John Hays, born in North Carolina and his wife Mary ? born in Georgia) lived in Lauderdale County according to the 1850 census. I assume John Hays died between 1850 and 1860, because in 1860, Mary Hays is listed as the head of the family. I would like to know Mary Hays's maiden name. (I wonder if there were any death records that might tell what these maiden names were.)

Apparently John and Mary Hays were married in Georgia, because they had 7 children older than my grandmother, Martha Elizabeth Hays) who were all born in Georgia, so I assume they came to Lauderdale County, Mississippi right before her birth in 1848.

Also M.M.C.D. Martin was sometimes listed on census records as M.M.C.D. Martin and other times as, I believe, Murdock C.D. Martin and another time as C.D. Martin. I was not sure it was Murdock, the writing was hard to read on those old census records.

Where do I go now to go farther back since I don't know where in Georgia or North Carolina to look?

BULLARDS

Bullards, at which a sawmill was operated by a man named Bullard in 1900 and later by the Kimball Brothers, is no longer in existence. It was located on a spur track of the M & O Railroad eight miles southwest of Meridian and became extinct when the mill closed in 1925.

BUNNIE

Bunnie had its beginning on August 25, 1890 when a post office was established nine miles north of Meridian with Ransom S. Richardson as postmaster; the office being named for his wife.

When the office was established there were only seven families living here so when the office was abolished on June 19, 1899 and mail sent to Topton, the place became a scattered community.

BUTTERCUP

Located six miles north of Meridian, near Ponta, Buttercup originated in 1885, being named for the abundant growth of buttercups in the nearby fields. An early post office at Buttercup was abolished in 1906 and the place came to be known as Jackson Springs. ←

CAUSEYVILLE

About 1884 the Causey family settled on a plantation some twelve miles southeast of Meridian. Causey opened a store and a church was soon built, a school established and a community was formed known as Causeyville.

This name could not be granted to the post office as another office in the State had a similar name. In 1886 the citizens concocted the name Edbony from the given names of two citizens; Ed J. Martin and Bonaparte Williams, the office being secured on January 5, 1887 with William J. Ellis as postmaster.

Soon a quarrel sprang up in the local church, with the majority of the residents on one side and "Bony" Williams leading a small minority on the other side. One night the post office which was located in the store of Jim Rainer burned and Rainer, being on the side of the majority refused to rebuild in order to do away with the hated name of Edbony. Edbony Post Office was officially abolished on November 25, 1889 with the mail being ordered sent to Meridian.

A new post office named Increase was granted in 1894 with Dr. W.J. Anderson as postmaster but when this office was discontinued in 1929 the name of the community reverted back to Causeyville, though it is still shown on maps as Increase.

Ed from Ed J. Martin + Bony from Bonaparte for Edbony

CELIE

Celie, located eighteen miles southeast of Meridian was established in 1900 when D.J. Reynolds opened a store, naming the place for his daughter.

A post office, which was established on December 30, 1904 with Floyd C. Hagwood as postmaster operated until July 31, 1914.
