Born - 1823 Gadebusch, Mecklenberg Schwerina, Prussia

Died - 1878 (?). Had yellow fever - was working on the railroad at Cuba, Alabama. Sent home unconscious. No one could get the family, who were all sick, so he was buried at the Paupers Cemetery. When the family went to find the grave, they could find no one to identify it. Came on ship "Bavaria" also. Came to Lauderdale County, Mississippi in 1870 with wife, 5 sons and 1 daughter.

GUSTAVE OLLHOFT

Born - 1850 in Preetz, Germany (Holstein), son of Karl Joachim

Peter Ollhoft and Margaretha Cath. Fredrica Ratzburg.

Died - Night of Meridian Riot with Typhoid fever. Buried in the path from the front gate in McLemore Cemetery, Meridian, Mississippi. Came to U. S. in 1869 on the Ship Bavaria, landed in New Orleans, La. Ship came from Hamburg to Havana and then to N. O. (steam and sail ship). Became a barber in Meridian, never married.
