Dear Mr. Bush,

It was so good to hear from you. I've been working on my family tree since 1967 and I've never had anyone inquire about the Scarbroughs.

The 1816 census in the Clarke Co., Ala. (Miss. Territory) Historical Magazine list Silas and John Scarbrough. The 1820 census I have for Mississippi lists Jesse in Jackson Co.; Allen in Claiborne Co.; Benjamin, David & Joel in Wayne Co.; David in Franklin Co.; Jonathan & Simon in Jefferson Co.; and David & Jeremiah in Covington Co.

I think that most or all of the Scarboroughs in Lauderdale and Clarke Co., Miss. were from Clarke Co., Ala., probably descendants of Silas.

I have 1850-1910 census for Lauderdale Co. and if you will send your family I will try and trace them back to the 1850 census.

Of the children of Frederick & Mary Ann Phelps:

Peter married in Mobile, Ala. to Mary Ann Jones, sister to William M. 24 March 1845.

According to my Great-Aunt Julia Jones, Buck and David went to Oklahoma and were captured by Indians and never heard from again. I don't know which son was called "Buck" unless it was Elisha. My grandfather was supposed to be 1/4 Indian. If that is true then Julia Ann Scarbrough Jones would have been 1/2 Indian and Mary Ann Phelps full blooded Indian.

I'm sure Frederick had other children, at least the 1830 Wilcox Census indicates that, however, the children listed are from my Great-Aunt Julia Jones' Bible.

My mother said that William Henry Scarbrough lived on a plantation in Louisiana with his sister and he was blind. Another cousin was Luther Scarbrough, a policeman in Meridian.

Rev. (Baptist) John Scarbrough came to Clarke, Mississippi Territory before the Indian War. He began preaching ca 1820 and died ca 1858. I think he is the elderly John in Clarke Co., Ala. He wasn't listed on the 1830 Clarke Co. Census, so he was probably also the John on the 1830 Wilcox Co., Ala. Census.

I'll look forward to hearing from you.

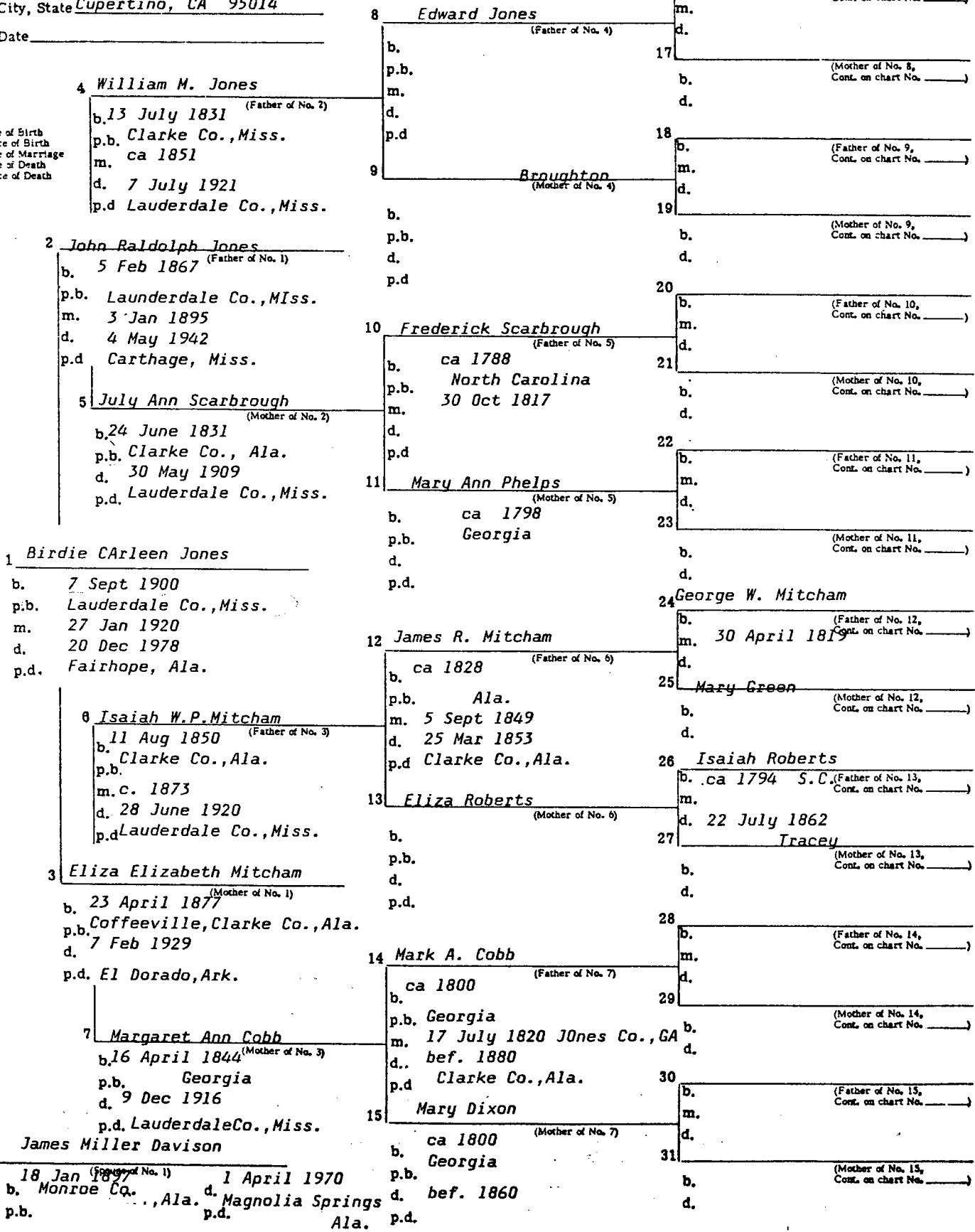
