He would have been 82 in that year and was probably deceased. I note that Jefferson Boyd did not have a son named John in any of the censuses. He could have and that John could have died as a child between censuses, which often happened in those days. Jennet could have been the name of Jefferson's mother, since he named his second daughter that.

Early next week, I will be going to the National DAR library and then later in the week back to the National Archives.

For this report, I have used up 2 hours of library research, plus 22¢ in postage, leaving you a credit of \$4.30. No charge for ancestry report on Mullins/Atwood.

I have again been delayed in my research time by a death in the family out in California but am back at the libraries again. Yesterday, I spent three hours at the National Archives going over censuses looking for your Sharp family as you had requested. You apparently have a mistake in the latest chart you sent me, in that you have an extra generation (that of Benjamin Sharp and Sarah Elizabeth Sykes).

I went looking for a Benjamin Sharp in Mississippi on the census of 1850 Index but only found one, and he was in Desoto Co, MS. I checked him out and he was age 28, born AL, and had a wife Mary, age 22, and no children. However, next to him on the index was a Bennet Sharp of Kemper Co, MS, and that's the father of your Henry Alexander Sharp. Kemper is an adjacent county to Lauderdale Co. Here is the census data:

One morning last week I planned to Washington but the temperature and wind chill added up to 5 degrees below zero which is a bit much for my senior citizen self. It was below freezing yesterday but I did the 10 block walk to the bus anyway.

Sharp, and I did look there first before I thought to check MS. On my visit to the National Archives next week, I'll work some more on the Sharp's and on the Gay's.

At the DAR Library, I took a look at the Edgecombe Co, NC, records and found something for you in the marriage records. Enclosed are two pages from that County record which show the marriage of Richard Gay and Levina Robertson, also the probable first marriage of Thomas Gay.

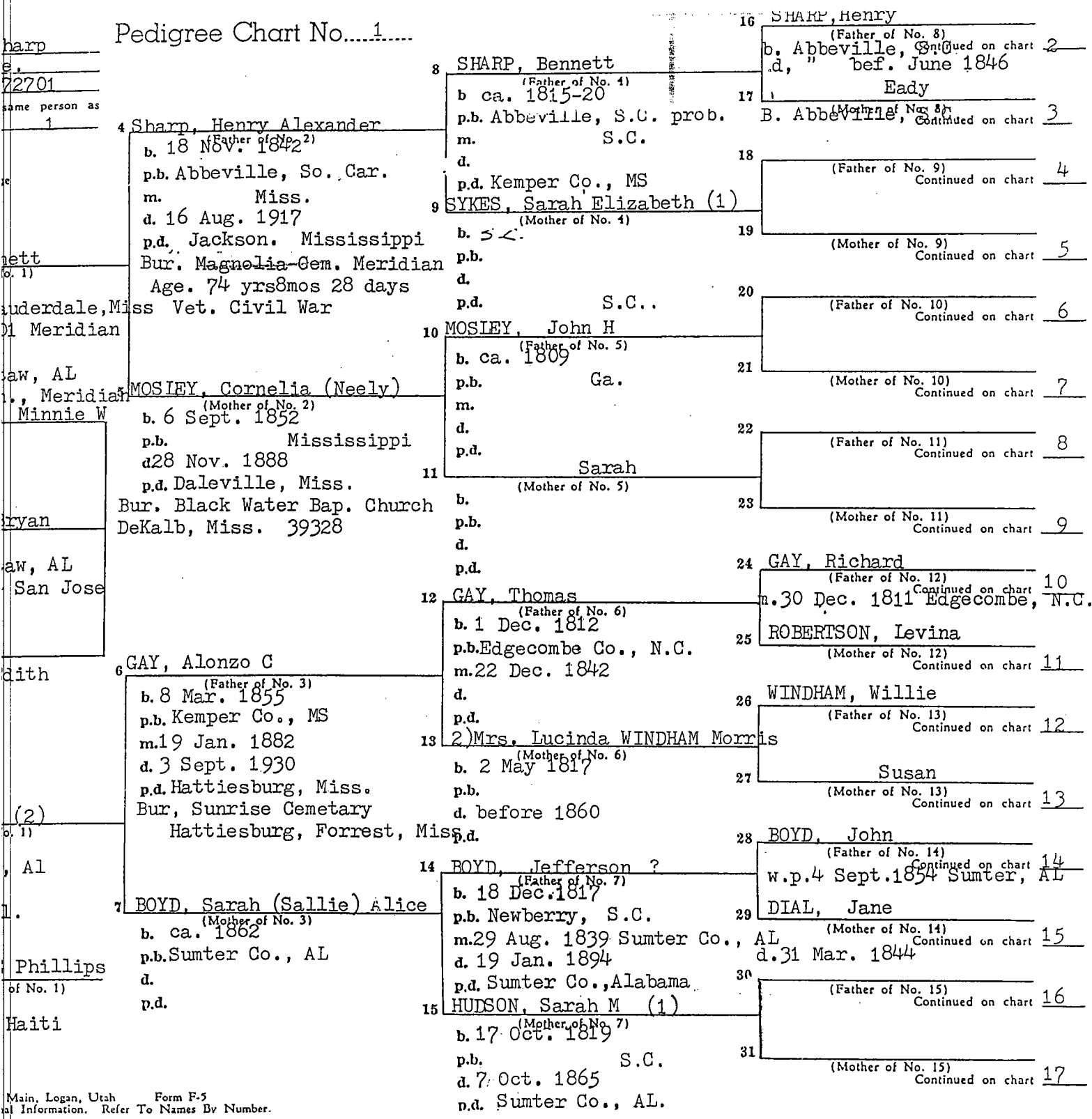

I was surprised due to the fact there were Mosley & Day there in the County. I checked my copy of the old Cherokee Baptist Association Minutes - found nothing. In some book that I have seen or read - the Day name stood out. It seems this was of a church record nature. Will keep looking. I have looked at various material in various Counties. It could have been Meador Co.

There doesn't seem to be any trace of these people, the Boyds and Day in the land record or the probate Court records - Have checked all

Of course I do not have copies of the Census records and won't check for I got the impression you had done so. I really need more info if you desire me to go further - Lots of people moved from Kumpas to Meador Co & on out to Jasper - Ark. etc.

Now if Thoma Day lived in the Benbowville area - which I think he did - then if he had stayed there he probably would have been registered as a delegate somewhere after 1878. He may or he could have died after

1878. You mentioned a Barton or Ben. Could this be B.S. Gay? The Rev George Gay must have been some kin and if he is same as Rev B.S. - then he must have left the Baptist + joined the Methodist Church

Before mailing this I am going to look through the old Voter List 1834-1861 Sumner Co. al. You are writing Jud - so you'll get County info from him. This has to be done presently page by page.

I did not examine the 1854 Land Roll Book at Debb - since I had found Thos Gay in Church records 1878.

Dear Mrs. Stegall:

I was given your name by a lady from Miss. who has been working on her family lines.---Ussey's, Perkins, Sharpes, and Stallworth. We have a common surname, Perkins, but cannot tie our lines together. I am hoping you might have seen my family in your years of research that might help me.

I am the descendent of Samuel and Elizabeth Marsh Perkins. She was the daughter of Ebenezer Marsh of Anson Co., N.C. Samuel and Elizabeth were married ca. 1804 and had many children. Samuel and his brother James left N.C. and migrated to Giles Co., Tenn. His son, my ancestor, Ebenezer Perkins eventually lived in Prentiss Co., Miss. There have been several of us looking for the parents of Samuel for years--to no avail. I have just recently found a James and Samuel Perkins who were the sons of Samuel Perkins-son of Rees Perkins who was born in S.C. They had won a lottery in Ga. in the 1807 Lottery and moved there. Have you ever run into anybody connected to these Perkins? I think the children of these pPerkins eventually moved to Marion Co., Miss. I have also seen reference to a Samuel Perkins who was selling property to a John Gilleylen in "Abstracts of Early Records of Monroe Co., Miss" by George Howell, Jr. Vol. 3.--This took place Jan. 20, 1820. Could this be the Samuel Perkins I have been looking for? The land was patented by Theodorick Walker. and was sold at Huntsville Ala.

Again the reason I have gotten in touch with you is to see if you know of anyone researching this Perkins line or anyone who is connected to a James or Samuel Perkins in your area. There are descendents of Joseph Perkins in Oktibbeha(?) Co., Miss. As far as I know we are not connected.

I have enclosed an envelope in hopes you can add a little light to this line for me. I also have a Gatteys(Gattis) line that lived in Ala. Is there anyone in your area that might be connected to that line? Thank you for any help you can supply.
