Peter and his brother John were on a 'wanted list' in Poughkeepsie, Dutchess Co., New York in June 1778. Peter is listed as "joined Royal Standard under Burgoyne 1777 with Butler's Rangers".

Peter is listed as having 5 children in 1786 and 9 children in 1798.

1794 - John and Peter were in Hope Township

1806 - (Peter lived on Lot 34 & 35 Conc D Hope Township before moving to Pickering Township. His son, Peter Jr. b1772, was 5'2" tall, had light brown hair and at age 29, in June 29 1801, he took the oath of allegiance in Hope Township.[Desc unknown Steiner 20 Sep .GED]

Notes for PETER ST. LAIRD MCINTEE:

PETER E. MCINTEE, D.D.S. Our subject is a popular dentist residing in Imlay City. He was born in Louth

Township, County Lincoln , Ontario, Canada, December 14, 1843. He is a son of James and Elizabeth (Steiner) McIntee, the father being a native of Ireland and the mother of Scotland. The former was a farmer and died when our subject was only about eight years of age. Thus bereft of his paternal parents the original of our sketch entered the family of Lyman Wells, a dentist of Simcoe, Canada. He there received a common-school education and at the age of seventeen he entered the Dental University of Toronto, Canada, where he remained for three years. He was graduated in 1862. Our subject was not satisfied with the instruction that he had received by itself, and spent two years in taking special instruction. He then became an assistant in the office of Dr. Lyman Wells, working with him until 1882.

Dr. McIntee was married February 14, 1863, to Miss Mary J. Horton, of Pelham, Welland County, Canada. She was a daughter of Zephaniah and Abigail (Thomas) Horton. Mr. and Mrs. McIntee have become the parents of three children, all daughters. They are Lenora Adelaide, Azel Alice and Nellie Lee. The second daughter married Andrew Cornell and lives in Imlay City; her husband is a telegraph operator; the youngest daughter lives with our subject, while the eldest daughter, Mrs. Edward Mulvey, lives in Toronto.

Mrs. McIntee died February 18, 1879. March 8, 1882, our subject was again married, the lady of his choice being Miss Mary E. Hutchison, of Simcoe, Norfolk County, Canada. By this marriage there is one child, David Yerex, who was born in Imlay City, September 21, 1885.

Shortly after our subject's marriage to the last-named lady he removed to Imlay City, where he has built up a good practice, being skilled in his profession. Our subject is Republican in politics but has never been an office-seeker. He is a member of the Masonic fraternity, having become so in Port Dover, Ontario, becoming a member of the Erie Lodge. He is also a member of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows in Imlay City and belongs to the Knights of the Maccabees. In both societies he has filled all the offices. He is a member of the American Home Protective Association.

Ernest William Herbert was born in March of 1869 in Ventnor, Isle of Wight, England. The 1881 England Census shows him living with his parents and brother Harry there. E.W. Herbert, his wife and two sons arrived in New York, New York on 16 Jul 1884 aboard the ship The Queen showing the port of departure as London / Plymouth and their destination as Michigan. There is no 1890 U.S. Census due to a fire so the next record we have of the family is the 1900 U.S. Census showing Ernest William, age 31 in Vernon, Shiawassee county, Michigan and his occupation as "Oil Trough Foreman". He married Nellie Lee McIntee of Canada in 1893 and at this census they had three children; Alice Mae age 6, Edwin age 4, and William H. age 2. (ABH)

We know that Donald Herbert, Sr. was born in Durand, MI and his family later moved to Hammond, LA. The 1920 census shows he was an "agent at radio company".  
Family legend says he worked for a furniture company and that his future wife, Dolly

Brooks worked as a clerk at a lumber yard. We can speculate that they met there. An undated newspaper article reported that Mr. Herbert was one of the youngest embalmers in Louisiana and had made the highest grade of 99 on his examination. In about 1930 he went to work for Baldwin Funeral Home in Jackson, MS and worked there until about 1937 when he began selling clay pipe and the family moved briefly to Memphis, TN before he returned to Jackson and Baldwin until about 1939. He was then offered work with Lum Funeral Home in Vicksburg, MS and later bought an interest in Glenwood Funeral Home there. Soon after WWII ended the family moved to Mobile, AL where he worked for Faulkner Concrete Pipe Co. and traveled extensively, He was transferred to Meridian, MS by Faulkner in about 1947 and then back to Mobile in about 1948 or 1949. Mobile remains the family home until the present time and both Dolly and Donald are buried at Mobile Memorial Gardens. (ABH)

Notes for ADELE MARIE "DOLLY" BROOKS:

Adele Marie "Dolly" Herbert was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother & great grandmother to her family. She lived a full life and died just one month short of her 103rd birthday. She moved with her husband and children to many cities and made homes for them in good time and bad. Some of her favorite homes were in Jackson, Meridian and Mobile where she raised her family. During and immediately after WWII, her husband traveled in a company car and she was frequently without a car from Monday until he returned home on Friday and stayed for the weekend, a difficult way for a housewife to live and raise her family.

Both Dolly and Donald were avid golfers and were long time members of Skyline Country Club on U.S.Highway 90 in Mobile. They are both buried in Mobile Memorial Gardens, Mobile, AL.
