Marydell, Mississippi
 January, 1907

Mr. R. F. Barnett;

My dear Nephew and family this will inform you that we are all yet on the land, and among the living and blessed with a reasonable portion of health and strength, and truly hope each of you are well, and enjoying life to its fullest extent. I received your good and highly appreciated letter of December 13 and would have answered it before now, but have waited until I could write to Russ Ray and have him send me the old family record, which I will copy. So here it is, commencing with your Grand Father and Grand Mother Barnett.

The foregoing is a record of your Grandfather Barnett's family. Russ Ray didn't have any record of your mother or her family, but if she had lived till now she would have been about 76 or 77 years old. She was Sarah (or Sallie) Hughes. Your Frand father Hugheses name was Lankford. His boys were Gabrel, (called Gabe) and William, and Jim. Your Mother's sisters were Polly, nancy, reny and lindy. Those of them who are living are in Cleborn County Alabama. One of your Aunt Reny's boys, whose name is Abb Burges, lives at Edwardsville Ala. by writing to him I guess he will give you a full record of the Hughes family. If you write to him address A. J. Burges, Edwardsville, Ala. He is a very rich man himself. I would love very much to visit you and if I keep in good health I may visit you next summer or fall. I would be so glad to see you, and I am so glad that you are doing so well-Oh yes in regard to your own age: Your Aunt Mary says you was about three weeks old when her and me were married, which was the 6th day of December, 1860. I will close by asking you to write often and come see your old Uncle and Aunt when you can.

ASHLEY COUNTY, ARKansas

About 3 O'clock last Saturday (Oct. 30) evening the quiet of our town was rudely shocked by the sound of three pistol shots coming from inside the closed doors of the Livery stable kept by Albert Sweney on the west side of the square, quickly followed by the announcement that Sanford Foote had shot and killed R. M. Barnett, familiarly known among his friends and neighbors as Bud Barnett. Nearly two hundred citizens were soon assembled at the scene of the tragedy and looked upon the prostrate form lying face downward in a pool of blood still gushing warm from two shots through the head, one ball having entered the mouth and lodged in the back of the head, or neck and the other entering the left temple and passing through the right temple, either wound being fatal, both having caused instant death. The two men named had been noticed by a number of citizens setting side by side on a bench just inside the stables door, which were standing wide open fifteen minutes before the shooting occurred. Nobody who saw them there suspected that there was any trouble or quarrel between them, and no one seems to have noticed the closing of the front doors just before the shooting occurred. As the crowd gathered in front of the building, Sanford Foote ran out of the back door and mounted a horse hitched to a near-by tree and rode away. What led up to or caused the awful tragedy is not known. There were no eye witness to the shooting, through many were passing to and fro on the streets near by about the time it occurred. The coro being abosent from the county, Magistrate Tyler White at once empanelled a jury of inquest composed of Mayor E. O. Bays, as foreman, J. L. Hudspeth, T. W. Ramey, J. R. Neel, L. E. Hayden, F. S. Bradford, J. H. Callaway, F. T. Bass, Jake Whetstone, Willie _____.

Sanford Foote was later murdered by Bob Sawyer who confessed on his death bed.

Jim C. Barnett Ends Long Teaching Career

With his retirement at the end of this term, Jim C. Barnett, principal at Harrison Central High School at Lyman on the Gulf Coast, will conclude a 47-year-career in education.


The Leake countian who was known as "Big Jim" during the many years that he was principal of Carthage Schools, was accorded praises, tributes and farewell gifts at a Jim C. Barnett Recognition Night held May 30 at Harrison Central. A reception was held immediately following the program.

Since July 1, 1958, Barnett has served as principal of Harrison Central High School in Lyman, Mississippi. Growth has keyed Barnett's years at Harrison County Schools. In his 11 years as principal Harrison County Schools grew from a student body of 1,100 to an enrollment of over 3,000 students. In the time the faculty, too, has more than tripled from 34 in 1958 to 115 for the present school year.

Barnett was born November 16, 1903, in Center, Miss., in Leake County. He attended elementary schools in Leake County and worked his way through Leake County Agricultural High School where he graduated in 1922.

He began his teaching career the following fall just out of high school. By teaching school for six months and attending college for six months (school terms were only six months long then) he earned a degree from Clarke College in 1930.

In 1932 he received a B. S. degree from the University of Southern Mississippi, and in 1937 he earned his master's degree from the University of Missouri. He has continued to do post graduate work at University of Southern Mississippi since that time.

Barnett married the former Miss Euna Moore of Sallis, Miss., in 1925. She is also a teacher and is presently a member of the Harrison Central elementary faculty.

The schoolman began his teaching in a two teacher school at Estes Mill in Leake County. Since that time he has never missed a year in the teaching profession, a 47-year record of serving the youth of Mississippi. He has served as superintendent of schools at Carthage, Tybertown, Carrollton, and Meadville; and as principal of Harrison Central High.

Barnett stated that his greatest reward has been seeing his many students go and make good in life. No financial reward could equal that, according to Barnett.


He is a member of Harrison County Teachers Association, Mississippi Education Association, Mississippi and National Association of Secondary School Principals and other professional organizations.




